Subject: Appointment of SVEEP College Campus Ambassadors.

Sir/Madam,

- 1. This is with reference to letter F.5/CEO/SVEEP/2017/15473-98 dated 11.6.2018 received from Election Officer (SVEEP) Office of the Chief Electoral Officer, Delhi.
- 2. As you are aware Election Commission of India organises various SVEEP activities/programmes to enrol left out electors especially youth and organise National Voters Day (NVD), special Drive, summary revision. For this purpose the role of student volunteers becomes important to enrol themselves as a voter and participate in the formation of good Government. In this perspective the concept of appointment of SVEEP College Campus Ambassadors becomes necessary. Their role is defined as under:-

Role of SVEEP-College Campus Ambassador:

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- (i) Identification of students, teachers and non-teaching staff and their family members who are not registered in the electoral roll and those without Electors Photo Identity Card (EPIC) or with wrong EPICs.
- (ii) Facilitating their registration in the electoral roll by providing forms and guiding how to fill the forms and co-ordinating with the electoral machinery for approval of the new applications, correction and distribution of EPICs to the campus electorate.
- (iii) Organising special drive for registration including online registration with the help of Chief Election Office/District Election Office.
- (iv) Educating campus electorate about the electoral process i.e. registration, correction of errors, transportation of names, voting process and ethical voting.

- (v) Facilitating inclusion of Voter Education in various co-curricular activities/festivals of the College Campus through different activities such as Slogan writing, poster making, quiz, debate, essay writing, song, street plays etc.
- (vi) Creating core team of students to work as volunteers for the Systematic Voters Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) activities in the college campus.
- (vii) Organising workshops for capacity building in Voter Education among student community.
- (viii) Organising National Voters-Day programmes in their respective college campus.
- (ix) Acting as an educator and motivator in family and neighbourhood and helping them in filling registration forms.

In view of the above you are requested to give necessary directions to Programme Officer, NSS and Associate NCC Officer of your college to appoint their respective SVEEP College Campus Ambassador (1NSS+1NCC) from neutral, non-political students in the college to bridge the gap in youth electoral participation. Each College Campus Ambassador shall be in position for one academic year.
