In past years the main problem for persons with disability is lack of knowledge because there were not many books in past that were accessible to them, but this pustakalaya contains all books that can help them in improving their knowledge and aid them in their higher education. The speech was very inspiring and motivating for everyone.

After this, a tasty lunch was served to the participants and the Volunteers. After lunch, our volunteers organized One Act Play competition which was all about acting and drama. Various

students from across all the Delhi university colleges took part in it. This competition was judged by the directory of National School of Drama of our college . The winners were awarded cash prizes and certificates. The judge encouraged the participants to keep improving and enhancing their acting skills.

In the end, a vote of thanks was given by convener of EOC DR Kanwar Singh . We had great support and assistance from EOC Volunteers especially from our executive members such as Rajat , Anurag , Richa etc. They cooperated and helped to organize the fest since beginning.
