COMPETITION- II:-General Quiz Competition

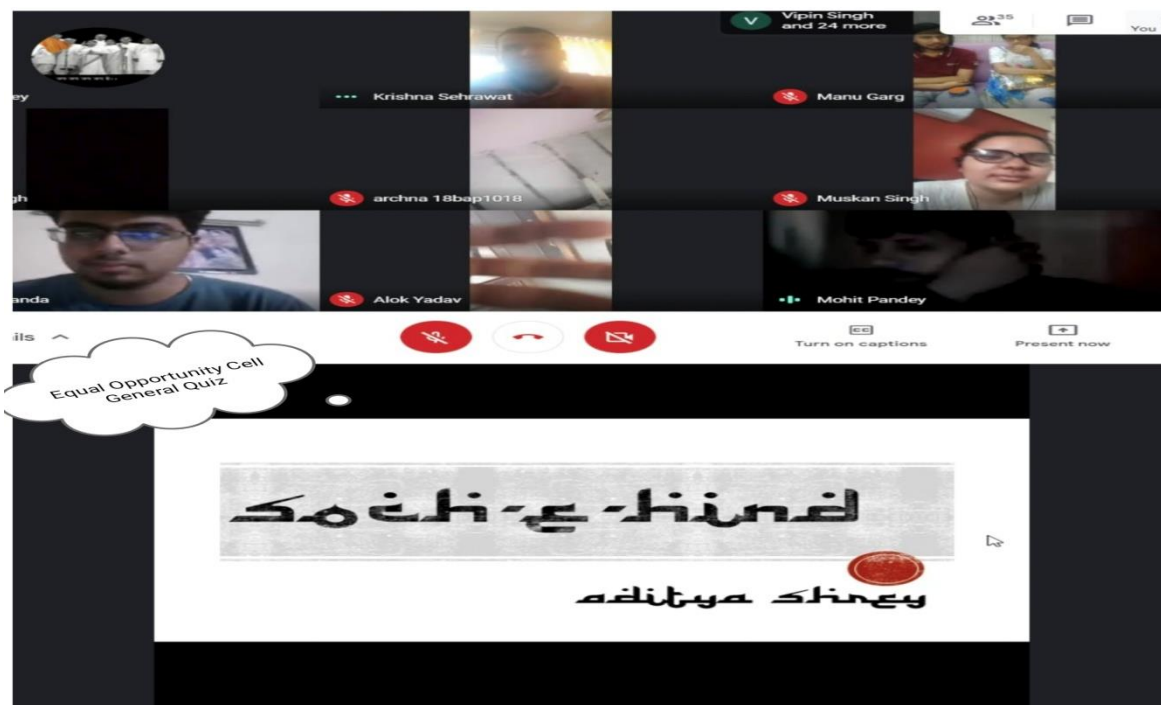
The quiz competition pertaining to General knowledge and current affairs was held online on Google Meet on 9th of March, commencing from 2:30 pm and went for around three hours. A total of around 40 PWD students from across colleges all over the country in teams of two participated.

The questions were prepared and the quiz was conducted by Quiz Master, Aditya Shrey. There were two rounds.

The Round 1 was an elimination round. A Google form was provided to all the participants where they had to answer a set of 10 questions within a stipulated time limit. Top 8 teams who scored the highest marks qualified for round two which was the final decider.

Round 2 was a live quizzing event. The set of questions covered various topics including history, polity, geography, current affairs and general knowledge. The quiz master asked questions to each of the teams and the teams had to answer the question after discussing with their teammates within a stipulated time. Correct answer awarded the team with 10 points. Pounce and bounce as well as passing were included in the contest and to ensure fair play, the quiz master requested all the participants to keep their videos on. The team securing the highest points won the game.

The participants were quite impressed by the brain-storming questions put to them and they were of the view that this was a great learning and enriching experience for them.

The topics included- 'Migration of thought,' 'Tears' and 'The Sound of Silence.' Participants were asked to pen down their thoughts creatively on any one of the following topics within a span of 2 hours.

Participants were allowed to write their works in two languages- English / Hindi. After 2 hours the participants were asked to mail their entries to the official id of the Equal Opportunity Cell or upload their entries on the WhatsApp group created for this purpose.

All the entries were duly checked and the best one was declared the winner.

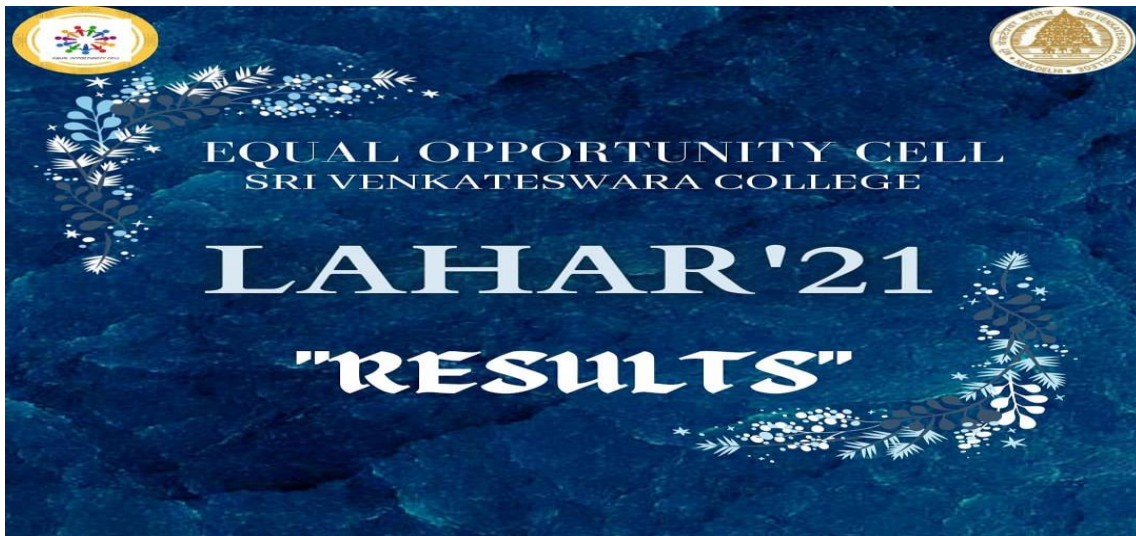
Picture of the entry that bagged the first place

COMPETITION IV: - Singing Competition

For this competition, prior submissions were collected through Google Forms at the time of registration only. The participants had record their voices and upload their audio recording files with the maximum limit of each file size not exceeding 10 Mb. The songs were judged on the basis of their Pitch, Duration, Dynamics, Tempo, Timbre, Texture and Structure and the best voices were selected as winners after a lot of discussion and deliberations by the jury members.


The Results of all the Competitions were declared on 13th March, 2021. **Cash prizes worth Rs. 45,000/- were distributed among the winners along with certificates of merit.** It's very rightly said, "It does not matter whether you win or lose, the most important thing is to try and enjoy what you have." Keeping in view the scenario of the pandemic, and the online education system, the event was necessary to add on an interest and spark in the college life of students.
