The second round was the final round. It contained 20 questions and a time limit of 30 minutes to answer as many questions as possible. The questions were provided in a Google form and the top 4 teams getting highest scores were declared winners.

A chat-room on Google meet had been provided to the participants to clear their doubts during the competition, if they get stuck somewhere.

Throughout the event participants showed a lot of enthusiasm. In spite of the fact that that events have to be organised online which has its own repercussions, this event overall was a grand success.

5. The fourth puzzle is the final puzzle marking the end of round 1.

6. Take the screenshot of each puzzle after solving it and upload it on the Google form provided.
7. Only one participant from each team must fill up the form and upload the screenshot. Multiple entries may lead to disqualification.
8. There's no time limit and top 10 teams solving the puzzles first will make it to Round 2 that is the final round.
9. The rules for round 2 will be given to participants qualifying Round 1.
