
The virtual event was scheduled on 24 April 2021. Aster Public School participated in the event which included the students of class 6 to 8 along with the teachers and the principal of the school.


2. Event



The moderator announced the results of the poster making competition, followed by a snapshot of the event which marked the end of the webinar.









3. Reception


4. Future Scope





a) Category 1 (CLASSES 4&5)











b) Category 2 (CLASSES 6, 7&8)
