
Calliandra sp.



Common Name: Powder puff plant

Scientific Name: Calliandra sp.

Family: Fabaceae

They are herbaceous perennial plants, shrubs, and rarely small trees growing 0.5-6 meters in height. It is native to tropical and sub-tropical regions of Americas.

Leaves are bipinnate, flowers are produced in cylindrical or globose inflorescences and have numerous long slender stamens which give rise to its name, powder puff.

Economically Important Part: Ornamental Plant

Economic Uses: They are generally grown in gardens and parks for their ornamental value.
