Activity Report

Exordium, the Civil Services Cell of Sri Venkateswara College functioning with a purpose to fulfil the need of a society in our University that can guide, motivate and furnish the needs of the aspirants, provide them with resources and work towards their personality development.

Continuing the work towards members of personality development, a brand new initiative KNOCK OUT Season 1 was organized from 13th-25th April 202, exclusively for the members of Personality Development Initiative.

Knockout was a tournament which comprised of a series of inter-study group competitions namely

•Quiz •Debate •Extempore

There were 6 rounds in KNOCK OUT Season 1-

Round 1- Quiz Round

Total 32 Teams of PDI participated and 3 members from each team scoring highest in Quiz qualified for the next round.

Guidelines for Quiz round-

- The quiz was organized through a Google form which consist of questions in MCQ format.
- Quiz was scheduled for 13 April 6:00 PM.
- It consisted of total 20 Questions based on general knowledge.

- Each question carried one mark each and no negative marking.
- Time limit for the quiz was 4 minutes. No responses were accepted after the deadline without any prior information about the issue.
- In case of any network issue, a screenshot was asked which was to be taken before the time of submission.
- Top-3 scorers from each group were shortlisted for the next round.

Round 2- Debate Round

Out of 32 teams, 16 teams were selected for next round.

Round 3- Debate Round

Out of 16 teams, 8 cleared for quarter final round.

Guidelines for debate-

- 1. There were two teams in each slot, each consisting of three speakers.
- 2. Team A and B, spoke for and against the motion on the given topic.
- 3. Time limit for one team was 6 minutes minimum & 8 minutes maximum.
- 4. Both teams were given a chance to ask one question to the other team.
- 5. Judges also asked questions to both the teams at the end.
- 6. From both the teams, one was selected for next round on the basis of their performance.
- 7. Debate was bilingual.

Round 4- Extempore Round

Out of 8 teams, 4 qualified for semi-finals.

Round 5- Extempore Round

Out 4 teams, 2 teams reached the finals.

Guidelines for Extempore-

- 1. Two teams participated in one round, each team was given a separate topic.
- 2. From a bunch of topics, judges selected one for each team.
- 3. From each team:
 - a. 1st member had given introduction of the topic
 - b. 2nd member talked about the core of it
 - c. 3rd member gave the conclusion
- 2. Extempore was a bilingual competition.

Round 6- Debate

Final participants were **Team Tigris** and **Team Amazon**.

Winner- Team Amazon.

The competition attracted around 150 members in first round.

Judges for the competition were the members of core team of Exordium.


Incentives for the competition were-
