The students' union was elected on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2018 on the basis of election held within the college campus using electoral voting system. Around 13 students participated in election and 6 students for 6 different posts were elected.

The students union came into effect from the same day. Various issues from the students were taken into consideration and a meeting was organised with administration.

1. First the timing and the procedure of dealing with the students by various dealing assistants was brought in notice in the administration and a considerable change was seen in the same.
2. The library issue was taken up and the book issue timing was increased by an hour and the library was made available for reading on Saturdays also. For providing good reading environment during the exams reading room timing was extended till 7 pm in the evening.

## Canteen

- I. The canteen was taken into consideration and for the beautification of whole canteen area including the kitchen area was inspected by the union and a significant change was seen thereafter.
- II. The canteen premise was painted on the request of the students union.
- III. Around 100 chairs were repaired and 50 new chairs were purchased and a request for around 100 more chairs has been raised by the union along with 50 standing table.
- IV. The area near the canteen was cleared and to make it more clean a request to make a landscape there has been raised.

- V. For making it more convenient for the students, Patym services were started in the canteen.
- VI. A proposal to install Mother dairy and Nescafe booth in the college premises has also been requested by the union and these are currently with the canteen committee.

## Other work taken up by students' union.

1. Alumni meet was organised by the college administration along with the students' union, which was attended by many alumni of our college.
2. ICT was also taken up by the students' union and all the issues like Wi-Fi speed and accessibility of ICT lab for common students were considered and with the cooperation of ICT Convenor, these issues were resolved.
3. Around 10 dustbins were placed in various locations within the college premises as an initiative towards keeping our college clean.
4. A sanitary vending machine was installed in the science block washroom on the request of students' union.
5. To welcome the students in the colleges 'Students' Union, organised "Union Freshers 2018". Students were provided platform to present their views about college and show their talents.
6. As society students practice in the auditorium lobby, washrooms were made functional and were open for use by the students. Also water dispenser was made available for the students there.

7. Serious concern for developing the auditorium was raised to the developing committee and it is assured to us that soon the tender will be uploaded for the same.
8. Open house was organised by the students union in which students interacted with the principal and the administration and all the important convenors like the canteen, ICT, etc. and various student issues were taken into consideration and quick action was taken on them.
9. Students' grievance portal was made functional and online tracing of grievances was possible.
10. To maintain the water purity chart of the water cooler, a request has been raised and soon will be acted upon as assured by the college administration.
11. **Wall of democracy** was made in the college for various posters and other ideas and thoughts.
12. Sports room and changing rooms were repaired. Washrooms were maintained and various showers and mirrors were reinstalled in the changing room.
13. Sports coupons were increased from 40/- to 50/- rupees per coupon.
14. Inter department Cricket tournament was organised by the Students' Union with the help of sports Department. Department of **Political Science** was the winner of the tournament.
15. On the occasion of the **National Science Day**, activities like T-shirt designing on the topic like Green Earth was organised. Students were provided with T-shirts and to paint on.

With the idea to promote the innovative skills of young budding scientists, Science Fair was organized by the Students' Union 2018-19, in the premises of Sri Venkateswara College, on February 28, 2019.
