The session highlighted issues of casual/everyday sexism, gender training, patriarchy and sexual harassment.</p> <p>It was followed by a Q&A where the questions, concerns raised by the attendees were addressed.</p>

Numerous bollywood movie dialogues were mentioned during the discussion, which contain sexist undertones to draw attention to the Gender training that works insidiously through popular culture.</p> <p>The audience displayed a mixed approach to the discussion, and while there were some who offered conservative ideas there was every attempt made to impress upon them the need to respect the ability of women to make their own decisions The discussion was fruitful and generated a healthy dialogue on the issue.</p> <p>The question-and-answer round consisted of multiple questions on the topic of sexual harassment, dressing choices, and what can be considered decent or indecent in an institution.</p>

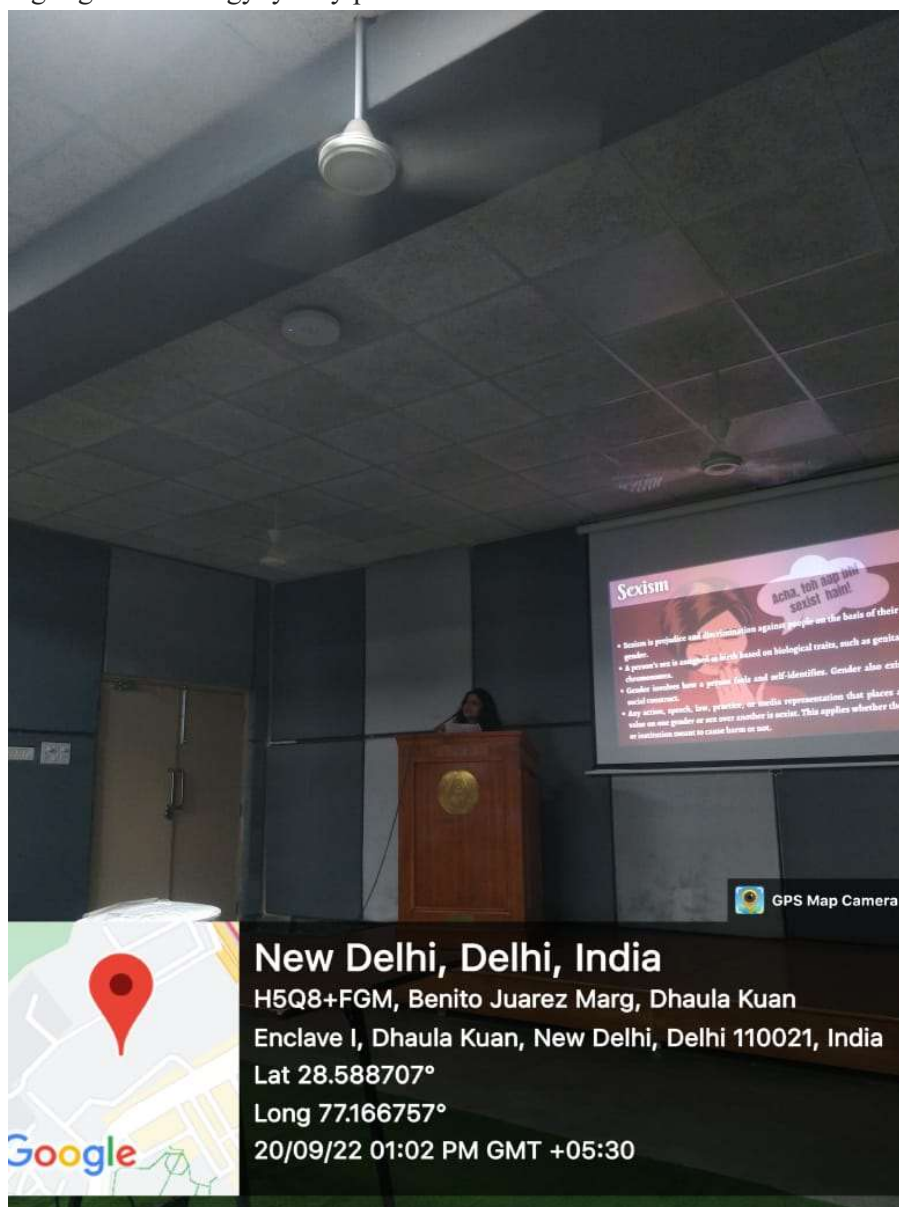


