METHODOLOGY	The workshop was organised by the Women's Development Cell and was conducted by Dr Rina Ramdev, WDC Convener.  The workshop was aimed at creating gender sensitive awareness among staff and students. The session highlighted issues of casual/everyday sexism, gender training, patriarchy and sexual harassment.  It was followed by a Q&A where the questions, concerns raised by the attendees were addressed.

OUTCOMES	The workshop provided a forum for students and professors to discuss gender discrimination issues. Numerous bollywood movie dialogues were mentioned during the discussion, which contain sexist undertones to draw attention to the Gender training that works insidiously through popular culture.
	The audience displayed a mixed approach to the discussion, and while there were some who offered conservative ideas there was every attempt made to impress upon them the need to respect the ability of women to make their own decisions The discussion was fruitful and generated a healthy dialogue on the issue.
	The question-and-answer round consisted of multiple questions on the topic of sexual harassment, dressing choices, and what can be considered decent or indecent in an institution.

The workshop, led by WDC convener, Dr Rina Ramdev, addressed various issues relating to sexism, understanding Eve teasing as sexual violence, patriarchy, as well as the important role played by feminism. The session was followed by an informative discussion, which provided a forum for students and professors to discuss gender discrimination issues. Numerous Bollywood movie dialogues were mentioned during the discussion to highlight the misogyny they promote.

The workshop accepted the need for respecting Women's autonomy and choice. Students from the departments of political science, BA Programme, and Chemistry participated in the discussions and made it a success.






