TOPIC/SUBJECT OF	
THE ACTIVITY	
OBJECTIVES	No prior knowledge of Spanish needed. The goal is to learn Spanish for study or work overseas. This course will provide you a general understanding of common vocabulary and phrases (basic information on him/herself and his/her family, shopping, places of interest, activities etc.), as well as fundamental grammar, Spanish pronunciation, and conversation skills, enabling you to converse in daily situations.
METHODOLOGY	The methodology adopted for teaching comprised lectures, activities, and audio-visual. A holistic approach was utilized to ensure that the courses are learned effectively and quickly enough to be applied in everyday situations within a few days of the commencement of the courses. Apart from the recommended, few additional Spanish books were done and sent in the classes to students to enhance their grammar. Latin American authors, writers, and poets like Gabriel García Márquez, Pablo Nerida, etc. were studied to understand the language and literature. Spanish movies like El Laberinto Del Fauno, Volver, etc., and music like Macarena, Me gustas tu, etc. were reviewed to convey the idea of the Spanish-speaking world, culture, and to boost their speaking abilities. Class assessments and oral exams were used to assess students continually. Various academic activities with an interdisciplinary focus were carried out throughout the sessions to cover a broad range of topics such as culture, society, politics, history, and literary and cultural studies of the Spanish regions. OUTCOMES	After completing the course, students will be able to understand and apply commonly used expressions and simple sentences to convey basic needs. The student will be able to describe himself/herself, as well as request and provide basic personal information about his/her place of residence, belongings, and people he/she knows. We cover present tense, continuous, perfect, imperatives, near future, articles & prepositions, adjectives, adverbs etc., a bit of Spanish and Latin American culture and literature and future with Spanish.
