1. INTRODUCTION

In the current times, entrepreneurship has been accepted as the fundamental basis of industrialization and economic development. India today has a lot of job seekers but the pace of economic development is determined by successful entrepreneurs who are job creators. Entrepreneurs materialize available opportunities for the working population of the country and their contribution to increasing national income is quite significant, as they are the persons who functionally coordinate various sources of production.

The **Department of Commerce, Sri Venkateswara College**, under the able guidance of our Principal, **Dr. P. Hemalatha Reddy** understood the need of the hour and therefore took the initiative of starting an add –on course on "Entrepreneurship" for the students. He also told that improvisation in the product is key essential, the more improvements will be done in a product, better it will be.



2. **DR. HIMANSHU TALWAR** interacted with the students from 12:30 p.m.-2:20 p.m. on 2nd February, 2019. Dr. Himanshu Talwar is an Edupreneur and winner of two National Level Awards for a significant contribution towards Management and Vocational Education. Himanshu Talwar, for more than a decade, has been working for International organizations; facilitating people-to-people contacts, and conducting training/ workshops for professionals and students. He has worked for the Government of Japan, Poland, United Arab Emirates, and top executives of MNC"s. He has studied and, attended Executive Management Programme(s) at University of Oxford, Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Calcutta and Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Bangalore. In his talk with the students, Dr. Talwar focused on key pillars of being an entrepreneur. He stressed on how to mobilize resources and planning for setting up your own venture.


