Common Name: Arandi, Castor oil plant

Scientific Name: Ricinus communis

Family: Euphorbiaceae

Castor oil plant is a species of perennial flowering plant in the spurge family, Euphorbiaceae. It is the sole species in the monotypic genus, Ricinus, and subtribe Ricininae. The evolution of castor and its relation to other species are currently being studied using modern genetic tools. It reproduces with a mixed pollination system which favours selfing by geitonogamy but at the same time can be an outcrosser by anemophily (wind pollination) or entomophily (insect pollination).

Economic Importance: Castor oil extracted from the seeds of *Ricinus communis* (Castor) is used as a lubricant, vegetable oil and purgative.
