


Objective






Speaker Session: 1 (Resource Person: Prof. Amit Kumar Singh)


Speaker Session: 2 (Resource Person: Prof. H.K. Dangi)

He concluded that analytics is everywhere and every job has an element of analytics. One should make himself ready by upgrading skill by learning and augmenting core competence with technical skills.




Speaker Session: 3 (Resource Person: Prof. R.K. Singh)


Question & Answer Session


On a scale from 1 to 5, how much would you rate the experts on the basis of their subject knowledge, communication, presentation and query handling


