Industrial trip to Honda Motors, Greater Noida

The Department of Commerce of Sri Venkateswara College, Delhi University, organized an industrial trip for the students of B.Com (H) and B.Com (P) to Honda Motors factory in Greater Noida on 13th September, 2016. The trip was attended by 54 students of second and third year accompanied by 4 teachers, Dr. Mamta Arora, Ms. Pooja Jain, Ms. Neha Singhal and Dr. Vinod Kumar.

The students and teachers were welcomed by Mr. Deepanshu, who is a Senior Executive with Honda Motors. The students and teachers were divided in two equal groups and donning Honda caps, they were escorted to various workshops by a team of engineers at Honda led by Mr. Vinay Dahiya. They visited workshops like Welding workshop, Paint Workshop, Control and Check Workshop. They witnessed the whole assembly line of production, right from the production of small, individual parts to the final assembly of the magnificent cars. They also witnessed and were highly amazed by seeing the robots carrying out the welding. There were 4 robots at each work station which completed all steps in an average time of 2 minutes. Being from Commerce background, the students found this extremely interesting and maintained keen interaction with the team of engineers accompanying them, constantly asking questions and understanding various processes.

The students got an opportunity to learn something new, which is beyond their course structure and witness how a factory environment works. They learnt about how the work culture in manufacturing industries is different from the corporate culture. They also got to know about management of new technology, how Honda responded to environmental factors or demands of consumers by improvement in its design, how vendors and the supply chain

management is maintained at Honda Motors and the high prevalence of Kaizen in a factory structure.

All in all, the students and teachers had a good and thoroughly enjoyable experience on the industrial trip. Everyone was served refreshments from Haldiram's and a nominal amount of Rs. 300 was given by all students who participated in the trip.
