The trip was attended by 35 students of second and third year accompanied by 3 teachers, Dr. Venkat Kumar, Ms. Neha Singhal and Dr. Vinod Kumar.

The students and teachers were welcomed by Mr. Rajesh Shukla, who is a Senior Executive with Moriroku Technologies. Firstly, they gave presentation about the history, business line, management structure, and techniques used by Moriroku. Then the students and teachers were taken to the shop floor level of the organization where assembly, manufacturing, and painting of plastic parts of cars are being done. It gives an understanding that how activities are standardized and simplified at shop floor level. The location of Moriroku Technologies is just 19 km away from lay in delivery as Honda Motors hold a finished inventory for not more than 2-3 hours. Then they gave one more presentation about the quality circle that how a group of employees meets regularly to consider ways of resolving their problems and after analyzing various aspects they found out and solve their problem which was hampering their productivity.

The students got an opportunity to learn something new, which is beyond their course structure and witness how a factory environment works. They learnt about how the work culture in manufacturing industries is different from the corporate culture. They also got to know about management of new technology, how Moriroku responded to environmental

factors or demands of consumers by improvement in its design, how vendors and the supply chain management is maintained at Morioku Technologies and the high prevalence of Kaizen in a factory structure.
