TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	A Complete Analysis of Stimulus Package 2020
OBJECTIVES	1) To know the impact of COVID – 19 on Indian economy 2) Detail analysis of stimulus package to revive the economy
METHODOLOGY	Research methodology serves as the backbone of any form of research. The paper has been developed on the basis of secondary literature available on the subject. The present study incorporated findings from various reports, websites, and other sources to draw conclusions on the subject. The government of India and RBI jointly introduced various measures and reforms to revive our economy in various sectors in terms of fiscal policy and monetary policy.
OUTCOMES	The major results of this paper show that the economic stimulus package of 2020 has significantly influenced the monetary policy including repo rate, reverse repo rate, cash reserve ratio, loan moratorium and fund allotment to NABARD, SIDBI etc. It shows the impact of this package on various sectors including agriculture, electricity, cultivation, micro, small and medium enterprises, civil aviation, banking, atomic sector and health. In the order to protect the interest of minorities during the pandemic prominent welfare schemes should provide sufficient funds to the migrant workers, women and labour class for their upliftment. The major impact of these monetary policies were seen through a reduction in repo rate, cash Reserve Ratio and Reverse Repo Rate leading to increase in aggregate demand in loans and increase in fund allocation to NABARD, National housing bank and IDBI. On the front of fiscal policies, the policies were centric towards the upliftment of the rural class by focusing on major government programs.

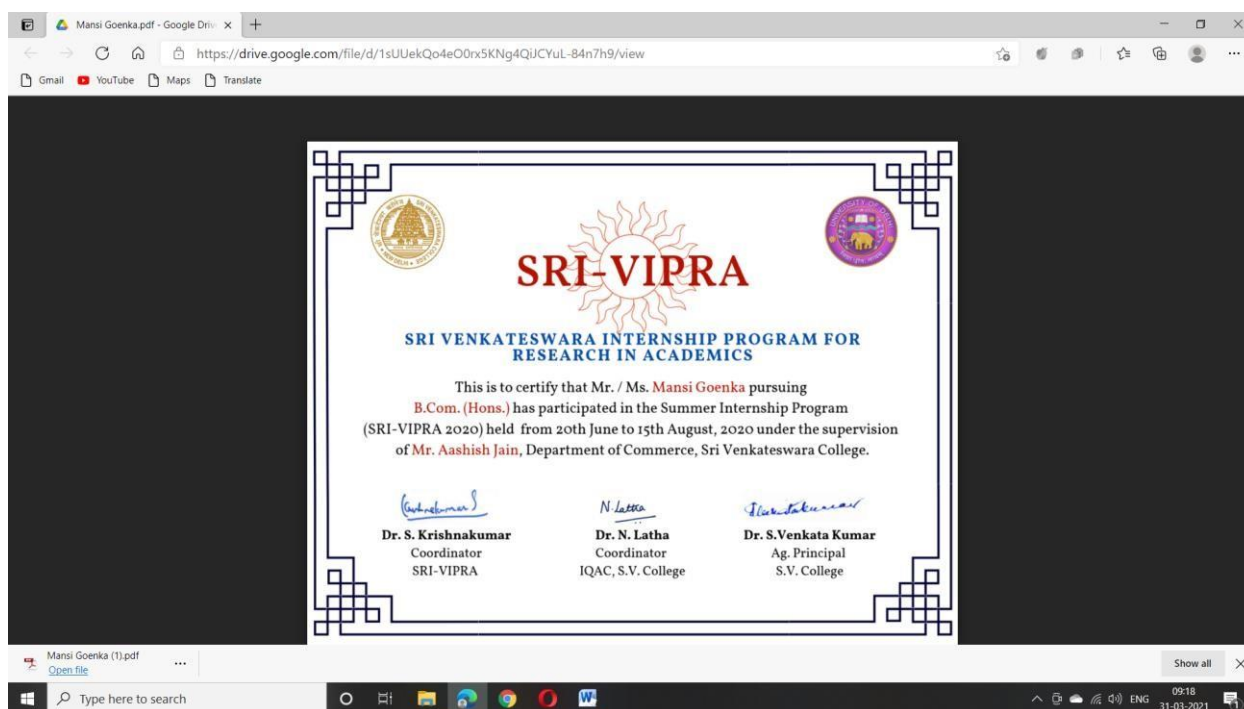


