TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Financial Literacy Programme
OBJECTIVES	To create awareness about banking habits among the women residents of Sanjay Camp slum, Chanakyapuri as per NABARD guidelines.
METHODOLOGY	The volunteers organized a <i>Nukkad Naatak</i> for a group of 60 women on the importance of saving, banking and self-help groups using audio and visual aids.
OUTCOMES	The women were taught how to fill the bank account opening forms and how to begin the self-help community groups.

Financial Literacy Programme organized by Department of Commerce,

Sri Venkateswara College

12 November, 2019

On 1st NOVEMBER, 2019, the Department of Commerce, Sri Venkateswara College organized a Financial Literacy Programme, under its extension activities, for a group of 60 women at Sanjay Camp, Chanakyapuri from 2 to 4 pm in order to educate them about the importance of banking habits.

➤ Objectives of the Workshop

The foremost objective of the programme was to create awareness about benefits of having a bank account and how keeping money in banks was more profitable than stashing it at home. Secondly, the programme also intended to create awareness on how to inculcate saving habits, invest in gold loans instead of buying gold jewellery and establish Self Help Groups (SHGs). Thirdly, the workshop aimed at acquainting the group of women with three schemes provided by the Government under NABARD i.e. Atal Pension Yojna, Pradhanmantri Suraksha Bima Yojna and Pradhanmantri Jeevan Jyoti Beema Yojna.

➤ Profile of audience

A group of sixty women residing in Sanjay Camp, Chanakyapuri were chosen for the programme. Majority of them were illiterate, however, few of them have had elementary education. The women audience was specifically targeted due to their limited outreach to banks and lack of awareness pertaining different government schemes.

➤ Committee Members

The financial literacy programme has been a good learning experience and would not have been possible without the inspiring leadership of respected Principal Dr. P. Hemlatha Reddy. We appreciate the guidance provided by our Teacher-in-charge and Committee member, Dr. Shruti Mathur. ➤ **Student Participation**

Students of Commerce department worked actively to make the programme a success. Through NABARD jingles and story-telling, the student volunteers taught women how they could not only keep their money safe in banks, but also earn a good amount of interest on it through saving accounts, post office savings schemes and various term deposits. To clear their doubts on NABARD'S functions and government yojanas, the student volunteers showed them some video clips freely available on NABARD'S website.
