#### **Report by the Convenor of the Bluechip Society**

The day was started by a fruitful session on "*Investment Opportunities 2020*" for which we had professors from Jindal Global Law School. It was followed by three mega events, namely, *Kaarobar*, *Dalal Street*, and *Mockstock*.

Our first mega event was *Kaarobar*. The event aimed at giving students the experience of those time when money was not the medium to get things and people had to barter their way out! In this several units of raw materials like land building and other things required to set up a business were distributed to the teams. Then different types of business were to set up the most number of business. Teams had to barter the raw materials among themselves. Each business is set up by using predetermined number and type of raw materials and at the end there was a surprise black market round to barter for the raw materials! The second event was *Dalal Street*. The event aimed at providing an experience of how trade used to happen in the past when every investor had to personally convince the other investor(s) to buy/sell shares without the existence of electronic means. The event had brokers who authorised the deals between them. It required quick decision-making, negotiation skills and foresight. The venue was filled with enthusiastic investors putting all their negotiation skills on the table and trying their best to seal a deal that will benefit them. The winners were: *First Position - Ashpreet and Sabarpreet; Second Position - Aryan and Tanisha*.

The final and our flagship event was *MockStock*. The key to making money in stocks is not to get scared of them. This competition provides that very opportunity to students to be fearless and to step in the shoes of an investor to face the wrath of the ever and suddenly changing market conditions and thereby, fluctuating prices. It emulates the movement of stock market without the use of money. The first round had the stocks of various companies being traded on

the exchanges, whereas in the second round the indices of various stock exchanges were traded. The teams which made their way to the final round faced a challenge of choosing and bidding among various IPO's on the basis of prospectus being provided to them in the final round. IT was a complicated MockStock done with ease, fun and enthusiasm from both the volunteers and the participants.
