


Activity Report



Key improvement areas suggested by the students for next academic session

- ❖ More practical application orientation along with theory
- To make the subjects more interesting with the help of audio-visual tools, ppts, videos, documentaries and other ways to retain the interest of students
- Notes at the end of every lecture to ensure easier understanding.
- ❖ If gap can be introduced between lectures
- ❖ Time table should be adhered strictly and in case of any change, please give the students enough time to prepare themselves
- ❖ More use of board or Microsoft word/excel for practical subjects
- ❖ More engagement in the class by ways of some group discussions, drama or presentations. This would also help us in our personality development process
- ❖ There should be offline exams because as long as the classes and tests are going online, there is no actual study going on really. This is the stage where we have to learn and understand what we are studying so I think offline exams would be very much efficient and better
- ❖ Teachers should ensure active participation of class with enough time to students to present or resolve their doubts
- ❖ Some personalized progress checking mechanism could be of help
- ❖ Recording of classes should be encouraged because at the time of exams, those recorded lectures can really help in revision and sometimes when we miss classes out of genuine issues like network error so in that case also recorded classes are a great help
- ❖ The commerce department can upload last year questions on the college website, that would be really helpful
