BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACTIVITY

TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	The Yellow Wallpaper directed by John Clive, based on the short story by Charlotte Perkins Gilman
OBJECTIVES	The screening and discussion aimed to help students understand the social construction of gender and how women feel entrapped within it, and discuss women's writing as an act of resistance and of grasping agency, as well as discuss the treatment of women's mental health in the nineteenth century. It also aimed to unpack Charlotte Perkins Gilman's view of neurological diseases and compare and contrast it with its film adaptation.
METHODOLOGY	The short film was introduced and subsequently screened by the English Literary Association. The screening was followed by a mediated discussion and debate between the attendees, including professors and students of various departments such as English and Film Studies from across the University.
