discussion regarding the various methodologies that can be employed for writing fiction with historical narratives.

The workshop was essentially aimed for SEC Creative Writing students and familiarised them with the technicalities of incorporating history into fiction. The invited speaker gave a detailed overview of the work being done in this area and explained students through his own research and examples followed by a question and answer session.
