Dear Madam,

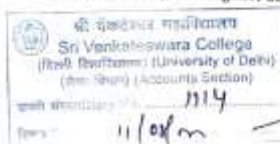
As directed by you, the Department of Political Science has taken the initiative to register Sri Venkateswara College (Registration ID: T-2022-2023/03028) for the purpose of organizing the Youth Parliament under the National Youth Parliament Scheme of the Government of India's Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs.

The objective of the Youth Parliament is to strengthen the roots of democracy, inculcate healthy habits of discipline, and tolerance of the view of others and enable the student community to know about the practices and procedures of the Parliament.

As per the Scheme, the following are the guidelines and details of the program.

1. The participants may speak in any Scheduled language preferably Hindi and English.
2. Each institution shall hold the Youth Parliament sitting on its own premises.
3. Each Youth Parliament sitting may consist of about 50-55 students.
4. The duration of the 'Youth Parliament' sitting should not exceed one hour.
5. To ensure effective implementation of the scheme, the participating institutions may invite an MP/Ex-MP/MLA/Ex-MLA/MLC/Ex-MLC or a Person of eminence as the Chief Guest who would oversee the performance of the Youth Parliament sitting of the institution.
6. The institutions shall upload the reports and photos/ videos of Youth Parliament conducted by them on the web portal for scrutiny and verification by the Ministry.
7. If reports and photos/videos of Youth Parliament are found to be in order after scrutiny and verification, participating students will get a digital "Certificate of Participation" and teachers-in-charge/head of institutions will get a digital "Certificate of Appreciation" for the program.

In this regard, the Department of Political Science is planning to organize the Youth Parliament Sitting, on 29th August 2022 in Room no.14. It would be a one-day event in which there would be a stimulation of the parliamentary proceedings and discussions would take place on an allotted bill. We are presenting The House of the people (Lok Sabha) and as for the bill we have chosen "The Juvenile Amendment Bill". We also propose Shri Tejasvi Surya, Hon'ble Member of Parliament in the 17th Lok Sabha from the Bharatiya Janata Party, representing the Bangalore South constituency to be the Chief Guest of the event.

YOUTH PARLIAMENT REPORT

Sri Venkateswara College, University of Delhi organized its very first "Youth Parliament" under the guidelines of Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, Government of India in the college premise on 30th August 2022. The event aimed at inspiring the young minds with the practicalities of the parliamentary democracy and provides them a comprehensive experience of how the Lower House of the Indian Parliament "Lok Sabha" functions. The event witnessed the participation of more than 50 students who assumed the portfolios of different members of the Lok Sabha.

The event was aimed at replicating the proceedings of the Lok Sabha and it hence started with the Oath taking where participants took oath in their preferred language. Later the session moved on to the question hour on the order of the Speaker where participants from both sides of the house asked questions to the concerned members of the Lok Sabha. After the completion of Question Hour the event proceeded to the Zero Hour where members from the opposition asked the questions on the immediate national issues to the concerned ministries and detailed deliberations took place.

After the completion of Question Hour and Zero Hour, the event moved on to the introduction of the "JUVINILE JUSTICE CARE AND PROTECTION (AMENDMENT) BILL 2021" by the Minister of Women and Child Development, the Speaker presented the bill for voting for discussion and considered it passed. A comprehensive and detailed deliberation took place in which members from both sides of the house expressed their views and concerns in respect to the bill. After the successful discussion on the bill, it was voted upon and considered to be passed in the Lower House.

The Chief Guest of the event Prof. Rakesh Sinha, Member of Parliament, Rajya Sabha, attended the event and addressed the students by giving them an insightful speech on how the functioning of the parliament has evolved. The Chief Guest witnessed the proceeding of the Question Hour of the Youth Parliament. The event culminated with the inspiring words from the Honorable Chief Guest Prof. Rakesh Sinha who gave his valuable feedback to students and congratulated them on the successful attempt to present the functioning of the parliament. He also spoke about the importance of bringing the subject of Menstruation in the mainstream discourse and the need to remove the taboos attached to this topic from the society. Prof. Rakesh Sinha also presented a sanitary napkins vending machine to the College in order to ensure his aim of setting up these machines across India to bring "menstruation health" in the mainstream society.

The event was a cumulative of spirit of democracy, vibrant opinions and the articulate parliamentary procedure and debates with the enthusiastic participation of the youth.
