#### **REPORT:**

The Department of Sociology of Sri Venkateswara College, Delhi successfully hosted the M.N. Srinivas Declamation on the theme 'Rethinking Prisons and Punishments in Modern Democracies' on 20th January, 2023. This prestigious contest is held annually for the first-year students from the departments of sociology in various colleges under the University of Delhi.

Participants in teams of two represented ten colleges from across the University for a chance to win the prestigious M. N. Srinivas Declamation shield. The students were judged in the categories of best team, and best speaker. Each participant had 4 minutes to speak their views followed by questions from judges, while maintaining their anonymity.

The event began by welcoming the judges for the event, Dr. Namita Pandey, Associate Professor and teacher in-charge of Department of Political Science at Sri Venkateswara College, Dr. S. Krishnakumar, Associate Professor, Department of Economics at Sri Venkateswara College, And Dr. Asheesh Kumar, Assistant Professor, Centre for the Study of Social Systems, School of Social Sciences, Jawaharlal Nehru University, who were felicitated by the department teacher in-charge, Dr Nabanipa Bhattacharjee.

The Declamation commenced with speeches emphasizing on an urgent need for prison reforms with an emphasis on rehabilitation, rather than retribution. A humanistic approach towards prisoners offering them moral and psychological support to facilitate their rehabilitation was also emphasized by different speakers. In the process, the participants also challenged the stereotypical perception of criminals and stressed on the need to reform the mentality and social perceptions before bringing about any change in the punishment systems of a modern democracy.

The event concluded with the president of the Sociology Association, Udheymann Singh delivering the vote of thanks to everyone present in the audience. This was followed by the award ceremony where the two speakers from the Department of Sociology, Miranda House, were awarded the trophy for winning the Declamation as the best team.
