TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	In the year 2005, the department introduced the series of <i>Annual Lectures in Sociology</i> . Since then, a number of eminent scholars have been visiting the department each year, delivering the prestigious annual lecture on a diverse
	range of topics. The topic of the 2019 Annual Lecture was "Refashioning Selves: Class in the Times of Consumerist Modernity". The speaker was Prof. Sanjay Srivastava, Prof. in Sociology, Institute of Economic Growth, Delhi.
OBJECTIVES	To expose the students to the work and personality of eminent scholars and luminaries in the field of Sociology and Social Anthropology. To expose the students to scholars of repute whose work is discussed during classroom lectures. The interface with them makes their work more exciting and meaningful to the students. To enrich the students learning experience because they learnt first hand about research and theory and the experiences of eminent scholars in their long, sociological journey. The Annual Lecture by Prof. Sanjay Srivastava, was aimed at enabling students
	to understand the phenomenon of class as a system of stratification in its social consequences in recent times of consumerist modernity.
METHODOLOGY	The scholar of eminence was contacted by Dr. Geeta Sodhi and invited to speak on a subject of his choice at a date of mutual convenience. The speaker was honoured by being presented the college plaque by the Principal as well as a shawl by the department. A modest honorarium was also offered.
OUTCOMES	The Annual Lecture was followed by a discussion, in which both students and teachers engaged with the speaker. Students learnt how the institutions of religion and family and the dimension of gender interweave with the idea of class in daily life. The speaker stayed on to engage in informal interaction with the students, which the latter found very enriching and exciting. Students learnt about the research and experiences of Prof. Sanjay Srivastava, an eminent sociologist, besides meeting him in person.




