

### Report On

#### **An Educational Trip to Kedarnath Wildlife Sanctuary, Uttarakhand, India**

An educational trip to Kedarnath Wildlife Sanctuary, Uttarakhand, India, was organised as a part of curriculum for B.Sc. (Hons) Zoology students {30 students with 2 teachers (Dr Om Prakash and Dr Preeti Khandelwal)} on 26<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

Kedarnath Wildlife Sanctuary is also known as Kedarnath Musk Deer Sanctuary established in 1972. It is located in the Himalayan highlands with an elevation from 1160 m to 7068m (Chamoli & Rudrapur District of Uttarakhand), lies in the upper catchment of the Alaknanda and Mandakini rivers which are major tributaries of Ganges. It is a primarily a protected area for the endangered Himalayan Musk deer. It is rich in biological diversity and also famous for alpine musk deer, Himalayan Thar, Himalayan Griffon, Himalayan Black bear, snow leopard and some important medicinal herbs. The sanctuary has a musk deer breeding centre. Musk deer is valued for its glands, the secretion of which, is used in perfume industry. Musk deer is highly endangered. There is also a high altitude botanical field station established at Tungnath. Students observed Deer, Wild Boar, Himalayan Monal while their trek to the sanctuary.
