Please note that "Mobile Phones" and any other "Electronic Device" is <u>not allowed</u> inside the polling booth. Every voter can elect up to Two Female representatives and One Male representative through the transparent democratic process of secret ballot.

This is for the information of all concerned that the NOTA or 'None of the Above' has been provided as an option to the voters of India in most elections. Through the usage of NOTA, a citizen can choose not to vote for any candidate who is contesting the elections. However, NOTA in India does not guarantee dismissal of the winning candidate. Therefore, it's only a method to give negative feedback. NOTA does not hold any electoral value i.e. even if the maximum votes are for NOTA, the candidate with maximum vote share will still be the winner.

It may clearly be noted that through the usage of NOTA, a voter can choose not to vote for any candidate who is contesting the elections. It may further be noted that if a student has opted for NOTA and also marked against any one or more candidates, the vote cast by them will be treated as invalid, as per rules.

 Election Commission of India (ECI) has stated that "...even if, in any extreme case, the number of votes against NOTA is more than the number of votes secured by the candidates, the candidate who secures the largest number of votes among the contesting candidates shall be declared to be elected.
