## International Seminar on Digital Transformation for Academic Libraries 27th April, 2024 at Sri Venkateswara College, University of Delhi

# **REPORT**

International Seminar on Digital Transformation for Academic Libraries was organised in Hybrid Mode: Face to face and online was scheduled to be held on 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 by Sri Venkateswara College (DU) Supported by Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) in association with Special Libraries Association, Asia Community (USA) And Society for Library Professionals (India).

The International Seminar on Digital Transformation for Academic Libraries brought together experts, practitioners, and participants from across the globe. It acted as hub for promoting knowledge sharing, networking, and collaboration in advancing digital transformation efforts within academic libraries. The seminar yielded substantial benefits for librarians, information professionals, researchers, teachers, and students, facilitating exchange of ideas and best practices.

Attendees: The international seminar drew in more than 150 professionals from 4 countries spanning North and South regions of the world. Participants included librarians, information professionals, researchers, educators, and students, reflecting a diverse range of perspectives and experiences within the academic library community.

The broad theme of the Seminar was "Digital Transformation for Academic Libraries". As libraries are changing rapidly, mainly due to advances in ICT we have entered in the age of Internet-driven library science. Information seekers are now turning to their mobile devices to meet their needs for knowledge and information. On the other hand, the community of library and information science professionals is duty-bound. They have to ensure continuous, free and equitable access to knowledge and the preservation of our cultural and scientific heritage.



With the theme of the Seminar, primary goal of this international event was to establish a platform for the exchange of relevant knowledge and skills for information professionals in Asia with a global perspective and to engage in discussions and exchange of ideas around the central theme and emerging technologies. Specifically, the objectives include promoting professional understanding of digital transformation in academic libraries and other cutting-edge technologies within the library and information science domain, to enhance the quality and dissemination of services.

The international event was an opportunity to put forward innovative plans, debate as well as new ideas, and foster close collaboration among participants from diverse backgrounds. The seminar provided an international platform for all professionals, researchers, as well as library users to present practical and theoretical discussions.

Technical sessions throughout the day provided interesting discussions on topics such as revolutionary technologies and innovation in library services and practices, IPR/copyright issues in print and digital environments, artificial intelligence, etc.

Digital Transformation for Academic Libraries brought together special invited speakers from the Philippines and Université de Strasbourg, LORIA, in an online platform. The discussion centered around the significance of digitalization in modern libraries and strategies to enhance it to meet the demands of the current era.

## **Inauguration Ceremony**

The international Seminar was inaugurated on 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. with the blessings of the almighty by lighting the ceremonial lamp by Prof. Vajala Ravi Hon'ble Principal, Sri Venkateswara College (DU), Prof. K Chandramani Singh, Vice-Principal, Sri Venkateswara College, and other esteemed speakers on the dais.
