Dr. N. Latha, Coordinator IQAC informed the members about the establishment of IQAC in the College and introduced the members of the IQAC. She highlighted about the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) which gives overall picture of an institutional growth in all the seven criteria's identified by NAAC. The Coordinator, IQAC presented the activities carried out in the academic year 2016-2017.

The Committee recommended taking the following steps to improve the quality of the College:

 At the beginning of the academic year, a College Almanac with a repository of academic events including meetings, extracurricular events, internal mid semester examinations, research projects and study tours/field trips/excursions should be designed. An academic calendar in consultations with teacher in charges of respective departments could help college for effective time management.

2. Apart from providing a degree, college education should also focus on skill development programmes. Vocational courses can be offered and better still the college can aspire to become a leading institute in skill based courses.

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- 3. It was discussed that the IQAC should also evolve mechanisms for Internal Academic Audits of all the Departments. This will help to evaluate students' performance, teaching methodologies and identifying weaker students. It was suggested that remedial classes for weaker students will improve the performance for better results.
- Orientation classes by faculty for higher studies/employment opportunities will guide and counsel students for better opportunities in higher education and employment.
- The setting up of Language Lab was discussed for promotion of languages like Tamil, Telugu, Hindi and Sanskrit in the college. The labs will help students improve their language and communication skills.
- 6. Dr. P. Hari Prasad emphasized the need to generate funds from dignitaries (Donors) by conducting various meetings that can be used for overall development of the College. He also recommended a course on "English Language Proficiency" that will benefit students from weaker sections.
- 7. Dr. Rajiv Tandon emphasized on various measures to be adopted for the college to become visionary in this fast-changing world of education. He emphasized that the college must broaden its horizons to be able to compete with other global colleges. He encouraged the College to think out of the box. He said that this quality exercise should be taken as an opportunity to place the college in the global arena and to achieve for a deemed University status.
- Ms Pawan Sharma emphasized the need to have a strong network of our alumni who can contribute hugely in presenting an impressive face of the institution.
- 9. The importance of embedding digital resources in various functioning of the College was discussed. The College also needs to develop E-resources for lectures, online quizzes, assignments. It was informed that development of E-Museums and e-Flora of the campus is already in progress.
- It was decided that a workshop/training shall be conducted for the non-teaching staff as well as training in several aspects of office automation procedures.
- 11. Dr. N. Latha also shared that the IQAC has proposed to hold a Symposium on "Quality Enhancement in Higher Educaion "for faculty and staff of the College in the month of April 2017.
- 12. The Committee also agreed to collect feedbacks from all stakeholders in right time. These should be analyzed and proper action is to be taken regarding the functioning and performance of the institution, and in augmenting students' support services.
- Steps to introduce Mobile App of Sri Venkateswara College to be taken for wider use by faculty and students.
- The College should also work towards effective waste-disposal system for Biowaste, Chemical waste, food waste and E-waste.

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- The Committee also resolved that the AQAR (2016-17) be prepared at an early date and for 15. that purpose appropriate personnel be communicated and followed up. The Committee also proposed that that comprehensive proformae be designed for collecting relevant data from al functional areas for the purpose of preparation and submission of AQAR to NAAC.

Reporting Items

- Dr. N. Latha informed the members about the College being ranked as 14th under the National Rankings under MHRD- NIRF 2020. She discussed the parameter-wise score obtained by the college.
- 2. She also informed the members about the Education World India College ranking the college at 6th position under the Non-autonomous College category.
- Dr. N. Latha presented all the programs/activities carried out under IQAC in a presentation format. She informed that the following programs have been carried out –
 - NAAC Sponsored National Seminar on Quality in Higher Education organized by IQAC, Sri Venkateswara College on Oct 18-19,2019 inaugurated by Shri R. Subrahmanyam, Secretary, MHRD, Govt. of India, Prof Surendra Prasad, Former Chairman, National Board of Accreditation and Former Director, IIT Delhi, Prof.

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- N.V.Varghese, Vice Chancellor , NEUPA, Delhi and Dr. Meenakshi Gopinath, Former Principal, Lady Shri Ram College.
- ii. Disaster Management Mock Drill and Training Session in association with NDMA and NSS. College was organized on Jan 8, 2020.
- iii. In the event of the COVID-Pandemic, a handbook (in Hindi & Telugu) on understanding the Coronavirus pandemic and staying protected was published in association with The Hindu and the same has been uploaded in the College website.
- iv. An online student feedback using google forms was designed by IQAC to evaluate the online teaching following lockdown. This survey was carried out in April with around 1892 responses. The same was analyzed and the report was forwarded to the University of Delhi.
- v. Two webinars were organized under the aegis of IQAC-
 - a) Live Webinar on COVID Myths, Mental Health Issues and Staying Healthy and Safe during COVID-19 was organized in association with AIIMS, Delhi from April 27-29, 2020
 - b) 1 Day Live Webinar entitled "Homestays in COVID-19: Prospects and Challenges was organized on July 10, 2020 under the Pilot project sponsored by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Changes (MoEF& CC) and National Mission Himalayan Studies (NMHS)

The coordinator also informed that workshops were being planned in the area of Technology enabled teaching learning process and in Intellectual Property Rights (IPR).

- vi. SRIVIPRA 2020 Sri Venkateswara Summer Internship Program for Research in academics was initiated by IQAC to provide a platform for undergraduate students to participate in summer projects for 4-6 weeks under the guidance of faculty mentor. Around 39 projects with around 300 student internships are being offered in the summer (June 2020-July 2020) this year
- vii. The Committee approved the submission of AQAR report 2018-2019 to NAAC and submission of Utilization Certificate of the UGC-IQAC funding received to UGC.

Items for Consideration

The Committee deliberated upon the activities to be taken up for improving quality measures and recommended the following -

- The Committee suggested redesigning the College website for better interface and visual appeal. The Committee also suggested for implementation of integrated ERP for effective academic and administrative functioning of the College.
- The Committee recommended the following infrastructure developments —Crèche Facility, washrooms/ E-toilets for specially challenged staff and students and ICT enabled classrooms.
- The Committee also suggested to the College working out the possibility of creating individual space and work stations for teachers in the new normal following the lockdown due to COVID-19 pandemic.

- The members suggested that alumni Association of the College should be registered and the Committee recommended regular meetings with alumni and create a database of registered alumni.
- With regard to sustainable ellernative energy conservation and resources in the campus, the Committee recommended taking up Water Harvesting and Solar Paneling on an urgent basis
- 6 The IQAC Committee suggested that a Counselor may be appointed for student counseling as well as counseling for resident students in hostel.
- The Committee also suggested appointing a Public Relations Officer for media interaction and also working towards increasing public perception about the College.
- 8. The Committee also recommended to organize training for non-teaching staff on Eprocurement /waste disposal and an orientation program in office staff
- The Committee recommended to strengthen activities for promotion of ethics and human values in higher education.


It has always been our endeavor to improve the academic as well as non-academic atmosphere in our college. Needless to say, the feedback of students, who are one of the most important stakeholders in the process, is an essential input in this exercise. Our teachers, administrative staff and other functionaries have a regular and continuous interaction with the students at various levels and in various capacities. Hence as an innovative exercise, we carried out a sample survey to gauge the perceptions, aspirations, expectations as well as the problems that the students face in our college. The objective of this exercise was to obtain the feedback and constructive suggestions from the students to help us chart out action plans for betterment of the college. A structured questionnaire was developed and administered across departments and across batches. Every course that is taught in the college was covered in the survey and to each of the departments a set of ten questionnaires were given to be distributed amongst students of all the three years. The students were given total privacy while responding to the questions and were requested to give their frank opinions about all the matters raised.

SECTION I: ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT

- Individual academic performance as perceived by the students (on a scale of 5): 3.6
- Quality of teaching as perceived by the students (on a scale of 5): 3.8
- On the use of teaching aids primarily ICT in classroom teaching, the students appeared to be satisfied, with 73% of the students rating the usage of such tools from good to excellent.




 More than 50% of the respondent students found the classroom teaching and engagement by teachers to be inspiring while 4% respondents found this to be not the case.






Another encouraging aspect of student response to their classroom atmosphere was the
fact that more than 50% of the respondents felt that the teachers were able to modify and
adapt their reaching methods and pedagogy to suit the different learning speeds and
patterns of the students.



 The students were also positive on the career guidance that they received from their teachers in classes and through other engagements with them.



The time management of the teachers in meeting their teaching schedules and deadlines
was also perceived to be quite efficient by the students, with around 80% of the
respondents rating it from good to excellent.




 As regards the efficacy of the contact hours of the teachers, the students gave a score of 4.2, 3.9 and 2.9 for regularity, problem solving and discussion on personal issues respectively.



the college ranged from satisfactory to good.




SECTION IV: CAMPUS LIFE





Which mode of teaching do you prefer? 417 responses





Dr. N. Latha, Coordinator IQAC informed the members about the establishment of IQAC in the College and introduced the members of the IQAC. She highlighted about the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) which gives overall picture of an institutional growth in all the seven criteria's identified by NAAC. The Coordinator, IQAC presented the activities carried out in the academic year 2016-2017.

The Committee recommended taking the following steps to improve the quality of the College:

At the beginning of the academic year, a College Almanac with a repository of academic events including meetings, extracurricular events, internal mid semester examinations, research projects and study tours/field trips/excursions should be designed. An academic calendar in consultations with teacher in charges of respective departments could help college for effective time management.

 Apart from providing a degree, college education should also focus on skill development programmes. Vocational courses can be offered and better still the college can aspire to become a leading institute in skill based courses.

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- 3. It was discussed that the IQAC should also evolve mechanisms for Internal Academic Audits of all the Departments. This will help to evaluate students' performance, teaching methodologies and identifying weaker students. It was suggested that remedial classes for weaker students will improve the performance for better results.
- Orientation classes by faculty for higher studies/employment opportunities will guide and counsel students for better opportunities in higher education and employment.
- The setting up of Language Lab was discussed for promotion of languages like Tamil, Telugu, Hindi and Sanskrit in the college. The labs will help students improve their language and communication skills.
- 6. Dr. P. Hari Prasad emphasized the need to generate funds from dignitaries (Donors) by conducting various meetings that can be used for overall development of the College. He also recommended a course on "English Language Proficiency" that will benefit students from weaker sections.
- 7. Dr. Rajiv Tandon emphasized on various measures to be adopted for the college to become visionary in this fast-changing world of education. He emphasized that the college must broaden its horizons to be able to compete with other global colleges. He encouraged the College to think out of the box. He said that this quality exercise should be taken as an opportunity to place the college in the global arena and to achieve for a deemed University status.
- Ms Pawan Sharma emphasized the need to have a strong network of our alumni who can contribute hugely in presenting an impressive face of the institution.
- 9. The importance of embedding digital resources in various functioning of the College was discussed. The College also needs to develop E-resources for lectures, online quizzes, assignments. It was informed that development of E-Museums and e-Flora of the campus is already in progress.
- 10. It was decided that a workshop/training shall be conducted for the non-teaching staff as well as training in several aspects of office automation procedures.
- Dr. N. Latha also shared that the IQAC has proposed to hold a Symposium on "Quality Enhancement in Higher Education "for faculty and staff of the College in the month of April 2017.
- The Committee also agreed to collect feedbacks from all stakeholders in right time. These should be analyzed and proper action is to be taken regarding the functioning and performance of the institution, and in augmenting students' support services.
- Steps to introduce Mobile App of Sri Venkateswara College to be taken for wider use by faculty and students.
- 14. The College should also work towards effective waste-disposal system for Biowaste, Chemical waste, food waste and E-waste.

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- The Committee also resolved that the AQAR (2016-17) be prepared at an early date and for _ 15. that purpose appropriate personnel be communicated and followed up. The Committee also proposed that that comprehensive proformae be designed for collecting relevant data from all functional areas for the purpose of preparation and submission of AQAR to NAAC.
