

REPORT ON DISASTER MANAGEMENT MOCK DRILL AND TRAINING SESSION HELD ON 8 JANUARY, 2020

BRIEF

A Disaster Management Mock Drill on the scenario of Earthquake was organized at Sri Venkateswara College with the help of DISTRICT DISASTER MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY on 8th January,2020. In this drill all Emergency Support Functionaries, College Administration and students participated from 12:00 Noon to 1:00 P.M. and after that a specialized training programme from 2:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. on Disaster Management for students and staff (teaching and non-teaching) was also delivered.

The following sessions were delivered:

- 1. Lecture on Disaster Risk reduction
- 2. Lecture and Demonstration on fire safety
- 3. Lecture and Demonstration on First Aid
- 4. Lecture and Demonstration on emergency method of search and rescue.

The Drill was conducted in the following steps:

STEP I-MOCK DRILL

STEP II-REPORTING BY DISASTER MANAGEMENT TEAM

STEP III-TRAINING PROGRAM

The program was successfully organized by the NSS team of the college.

STEP I

- 1. Three Alarm bells were rung at sharp 12:08 P.M. and after that all the students and staff evacuated the building and assembled in the Front Lawns of the College.
- 2. The **Proctor Dr. Ram Kishore Yadav** had made a call at 1077 at 12:08 PM.
- 3. The Emergency services made their presence felt in the college within next 15 minutes.
- The Emergency services i.e. Delhi Police, Ambulances, BSES and Fire Brigade had reported in the premises within next 10-15 minutes.
- 5. The NSS volunteers (casualties) were evacuated from the premises by the First Aiders by using emergency method of rescues: human crèche, pick-a-back, pick-a-back (reverse), fireman's lift etc. All these methods were later on practically taught to the students, teaching and non-teaching staff in the training program that was held from 2:00P.M.-4:00P.M.
- 6. The casualties were taken to the First Aid zone and were given first aid.
- 7. Mock Drill Starting Time was 12:08 P.M. and Mock Drill Closing Time

was 12:45 P.M. and the call ended at 1:05 P.M.

STEP II

- After the mock drill all the students, staff (teaching and nonteaching) and emergency services gathered in Room no. 13.
- Mr. Deepak Pal, District Project Coordinator, District Disaster Management Authority briefed everyone about the Mock Drill that was held in the Arts Block of Sri Venkateswara College.
- 3. He informed that 1077 is the Disaster Management contact number and incase of any disaster you can call on it. All emergency services are interconnected through it.
- 4. He informed that the response time emergencies was 15 minutes.
- 5. He explained that incase the Alarm rings thrice it means it is an emergency conditions and everyone should evacuate the building and go to the safe zone which is the front lawns in this case.
- 6. Mr. Suman Kumar, Station Officer.
- Solid fire -fires involving solid materials such as wood, paper or textiles.
- Liquid fire- fires involving flammable liquids such as petrol, diesel or oils.

- 8. Questions were posed to the presenters like how to avoid stampede in such situations. The speakers focused on not to be in a hurry and not to panic.
- 9. The Acting Principal, Dr. M.V.R Prasada Rao, addressed the gathering and thanked the Disaster Management Team, NSS Volunters, Students, Teaching, Non Teaching Administration. and He requested the team to give a video recording of the drill so that the same can be shown to students and staff during the orientation sessions. This will help to prepare all for emergencies.
- 10. Dr. R.K. Yadav, Proctor also expressed his gratitude to on and all and requested all to join for refreshments.

STEP III

- 1. After the refreshment everyone gathered in Room 13 for the training program.
- 2. Mr. Naveen Gupta, Trainer, District Disaster Management Authority, conducted a training program on Disaster Management.
- 3. He started out by discussing the 3 contributory factors of fire:
 - Air should be 20% or more
 - Temperature should be 37 degree or more
 - Combustible Item –any combustible item should be there
 - 4. Then he discussed four types of fire:
 - If its on the back, press your back against the wall
 - 5. In case of fire on cylinder
 - Switch off the knob
 - Wet cloth should be put on

- Gas Fire- fires involving gases.
- Metal Fire-fires involving metals.
- 15. He pointed out that the first step should be to call at 1077 and also informed various emergency numbers, 101-fire, 102-first aid, 112-police, ambulance and fire.
- 16.He demonstrated how to use fire extinguisher:
 - Remove the safety pin
 - Take out the green nozzle
 - Take out the pipe
 - Straighten the pipe
 - Press the nozzle fully
- 17. The fire extinguisher should always be used on the backside of the power.
- 18.It was also informed that a fire extinguisher should not be used on a person who is on fire, its better to use water, but don't throw water from a distance or use a blanket to cover him/ her or the person should roll on the floor or mud with his hands clasped and close to chest.
- 19.He discussed that how careless can be one of the major causes of fire and we should be very careful.
- 20.He discussed a few tips and situations
 - Don't run if a cloth you are wearing has caught fire
 - Instead roll on the floor
 - Human Creche
 - Pick-a-back
 - Pick-a back (reverse)
 - Fireman lift
 - Two hand seat (fracture in both legs)

- Pour water bucket on cylinder not gas
- Keep a fire extinguisher near kitchen area
- He suggested a 2 kg fire extinguisher should be kept at home and a 1 kg fire extinguisher in car.
- 7. He also mentioned matchsticks, petrol, diesel should be kept away from children.
- 8. Air conditioners should be regularly serviced.
- 9. Good quality wiring should be done.
- 10.Even fire extinguishers should be serviced.
- 11.He asked how many have a first aid kit at home.
- 12.He informed that a Disaster Kit should include following things:
 - Torch
 - Rope
 - Clothes
 - Glucose
 - Radio
 - 2 extra cells
 - Water that last 2 days
 - Medicines
 - Important documents
 - Food
 - Hard cash
- 13. He advised a mock drill should be conducted every 3 months.
- 14.At the end he gave practical sessions on Emergency methods of rescue:

- Three hand seat (fracture in 1 leg)
- Four hand seat (for heavy weight casualty)
 Many students and teachers tried out all the above stated emergency methods of rescue.
 - 15. The training session ended with a Vote of Thanks by the Principal who admired Mr. Naveen for his interesting training session.
