### BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACTIVITY

<b>TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY</b>	Mega distribution drive of ration kits for Sanjay camp residents
<b>OBJECTIVES</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. To provide essential food supplies to underprivileged families.</li><li>2. To help in reducing hunger and malnutrition among the vulnerable population.</li></ol>
<b>METHODOLOGY</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The distribution drive was conducted in collaboration with National Organisation for Social Empowerment, the NGO who provided the required food items.</li><li>2. The food supplies were transported to the venue by auto and van.</li><li>3. Ration kits were assembled by the volunteers, each containing rice, wheat flour, cooking oil, sugar, red and green lentils (masoor dal, moong dal).</li><li>4. Ticketing system was used to ensure a systematic distribution.</li></ol>

<b>OUTCOMES</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The NSS volunteers had hands-on experience with field work. They were able to connect with the people on a ground level and understand the struggle of the underprivileged community.</li> <li>2. Over 830 KG of food items were distributed in total. 250+ people received the kits and benefitted from the drive.</li> <li>3. The drive helped in improving the food security and ensured access to nutritious meals for the residents of Sanjay camp.</li> <li>4. Participants of the financial literacy workshop gained a better understanding of financial concepts like budgeting, savings, and investments.</li> </ol>

## REPORT

For people in rural areas, feeding their family is perhaps the most important concern. For many workers who live on daily wages, the smallest event like bad weather or an injury can prove to be a major obstacle. Affording food becomes a challenge and people are forced to go hungry. Initiatives taken by local NGOs and organisations like NSS play a vital role in addressing the needs of vulnerable communities.

One such initiative was undertaken by **NSS-SVC** on **September 21, 2023** under its **Project Poshan**. A **Mega Distribution Drive of Ration Kits** was held in **Sanjay Camp**. It was a collective effort of all volunteers, held in collaboration with an NGO. The **National Organisation for Social Empowerment** generously sponsored and provided over 830 Kg of food items including rice, wheat flour, sugar, cooking oil, red and green lentils (masoor dal, moong dal), and assisted in its transportation to the venue. The items were then organised by the volunteers and assembled into ration kits which contained a particular quantity of each item. To ensure a fair and systematic distribution, numbered tickets were created and distributed beforehand to the beneficiaries. Accordingly, volunteers distributed the ration kits to Sanjay Camp residents. More than 250 people from the camp participated and received the ration kits. It lasted for over 3 hrs and saw the volunteers work tirelessly to move, arrange and properly distribute the kits.

The distribution drive ensured that essential food supplies reach individuals and families living in the slum area, who often face challenges in accessing nutritious meals. By providing ration kits comprising staple food items, the event contributes to alleviating hunger and malnutrition among marginalized populations. It also helped raise awareness about the challenges faced by the underprivileged people and the importance of addressing their needs.

Overall, the mega distribution drive of ration kits was a huge success. It played a vital role in ensuring food security, supporting the vulnerable community, fostering community engagement, raising awareness, and promoting collaborative efforts towards social welfare.
