METHODOLOGY	<ul> <li>A display of submitted artworks handmade by students of sanjay camp was prepared and showcased at the embassy park.</li> <li>Small scale models of the entire ecosystem, as well as a bank were prepared and used to explain various concepts.</li> </ul>
