They are further requested to note the following for information and necessary action:-

- 1. All the eligible students who are due to appear in the Delhi University Semester Examinations, as per schedule, are requested to note that the UPC/Paper Code of a particular paper once allotted to them for a particular Semester (odd/even) shall remain the same for appearing for their Improvement/Essential Repeat within the specified time period despite any change(s) in the Title of the paper. In other words, the UPC/Paper Code of a particular paper is constant and shall remain the same, as per rules. The Examinees are advised to double check the Paper Code before starting their examination regardless of whether the content of the paper appears familiar.
- 2. Please ensure that the choice of examination papers opted for in the Examination Form, and the choice mentioned in the Admit Card is the same. You shall be permitted to appear only in the papers/subjects that are specified in the Admit Card.
