Notification Regarding Registration of GE/SEC/VAC papers

All the students of Undergraduate Courses Semester-I Part-I (2022-23) are required to register themselves for GE/SEC/VAC papers as per the following:

- 1. Classes for all GE/SEC/VAC have started for all first semester students. (See the details of GE/SEC/VAC papers being offered by the college).
- 2. Students can register themselves with the Teacher concerned/Teacher-in-charge of the respective departments and start attending classes as per the schedule.
- 3. The students are allowed to change their GE/SEC/VAC paper up to 12th January, 2023 and no change of GE/SEC/VAC paper will be permitted thereafter.

It may clearly be noted that all students of first semester shall be required to opt for a GE/SEC/VAC paper as per the following:

- 1. All students can choose one paper each from the pool of SEC and VAC offered by the college irrespective of their discipline.
- 2. All B.A(Hons), B. Com (Hons) and B. Sc. (Hons) students can choose any one GE paper other than their own discipline.
- 3. All B. A.(prog) and B. Com (prog) students can choose any one GE paper from a pool of languages (English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu) offered by the college.
- 4. Those students from BA Programme who want to take English as one of the languages in GE should opt for Sem I (English GE 1 for BA prog), and, wait for the other language in the next semester.
- 5. Those students from B. Com Programme who want to take Hindi as one of the languages in GE should opt for Sem I (Hindi GE 1 for BCom prog), and, wait for the other language in the next semester.
- 6. Students of B.A. program with two languages as the core disciplines can choose from the open pool of Generic Electives (and not restricted to choose only the GE-Languages)
- 7. Students of B.A. program with one language as the core disciplines can choose only one GE-language (which will be two courses of the same language that may be studied as GE-1 and GE-3 or GE-2 and GE-4). The other GEs shall be the open pool of GEs.
- 8. B.A./B.Com. Programme students who have never studied any Modern Indian Language (MIL) up to 8th Class can choose from the open pool of GEs.
- 9. B.Sc. (Life Sciences) students can choose any GE other than Chemistry, Botany and Zoology.

The Teachers-in-charge of the respective departments are requested to submit the final list of students opting GE/SEC/VAC paper for their department(s), to the office of the Section Officer (Administration) on or before 20th January, 2023 positively.

Note: 1. The students who have already filled the Google form in this regard, need not to send an email.

2. The minimum number of students to offer GE course by a department is 15.

3. Any addendum/corrigendum shall be posted on the college website only.
