**Sub: Amendments to Ordinances**

The following Amendment to Ordinances of the University has approved by the Executive Council at its meeting held on 10.10.2020/21.10.2020 are notified for information and necessary action, if any, to all the concerned:

- 1. Amendment to Ordinance XVIII - Colleges other than those Maintained by the Government of India (E.C Res. No. 26 & 15 dated 10.10.2020/21.10.2020)

Existing	Amended
<p><b>Clause 4. (4)</b></p> <p>An existing senior Faculty, may be designated as Vice-Principal by the Governing Body of the College on the recommendation of the Principal, for a tenure of two years, who can be assigned specific activities, in addition to concerned faculty member's existing responsibilities. During the absence of the Principal, for any reason, the Vice Principal shall exercise the powers of the Principal. The appointment of such Vice-Principal shall require the approval of the University.</p>	<p><b>Clause 4. (4)</b></p> <p>An existing Senior Faculty, <i>who fulfill the qualifications for the post of Principal</i>, may be designated as Vice-Principal by the Governing Body of the College on the recommendation of the Principal, for a tenure of two years, who can be assigned specific activities, in addition to concerned faculty member's existing responsibilities. During the absence of the Principal, for any reason, the Vice Principal shall exercise the powers of the Principal. The appointment of such Vice-Principal shall require the approval of the University.</p>
<p><b>Clause 7. (2) (c)</b></p> <p>On the recommendation of the Selection Committee, the University shall transmit to governing body a list of persons mentioned in the order of preference whom the University would be prepared to recognize as Principal or, if none of the applicants are considered suitable, shall refrain from sending a list in which case the post shall be re-advertised.</p> <p>Provided that the term of appointment of the College Principal shall be five years with eligibility for re-appointment for another term only after following the due process of selection laid down under this Ordinance.</p>	<p><b>Clause 7. (2) (c)</b></p> <p>On the recommendation of the Selection Committee, the University shall transmit to Governing Body a list of persons mentioned in the order of preference whom the University would be prepared to recognize as Principal or, if none of the applicants are considered suitable, shall refrain from sending a list in which case the post shall be re-advertised.</p>
