Notice -Admission to PG Courses II

This is to notify all the eligible applicants for PG courses that University of Delhi shall commence its admission (Merit and Entrance) to the following courses from 25th Nov 2020. The admission to some of the courses is either based only through entrance or through both entrance and merit.

a) Entrance Based Admission

- i. The admission list will be prepared based on the result of the entrance test conducted by NTA.
- ii. Irrespective whether the final year results have been declared or not, the applicants will be admitted provisionally. However, it is advised for the students whose results have been declared to upload the same on their dashboard latest by 1:00 pm, Monday 23rd Nov 2020.
- iii. Applicants who are awarded grades must upload the converted percentage.
- iv. The applicants will have to submit their final year results by the last date of admission as declared by the university.
- v. In case of Tie in the Entrance Test marks, tie-breakers in the following order of preference will be applied:
 - Candidates with higher percentage in Qualifying Examination as mentioned in the eligibility criteria, will be given preference.
 - Candidates with higher percentage in the final year of bachelor degree will be given preference, then preceding year and so on.
 - Candidates having higher aggregate marks (five subjects including one language) in class XII Board examination will be given preference.
- vi. In case the result of the qualifying examination has not been declared for applicants on tie, admission to that seat will be kept on hold.

b) Merit Based Admission

- i. Merit Based admission is granted only to the applicant who has completed the qualifying examination from University of Delhi.
- ii. The admission list will be prepared based on the marks entered by the applicant on the portal. Students of the University of Delhi under the Choice Based Credit System must calculate their percentage using the formula as given on their dashboard.
- iii. Option to update the marks of the qualifying examination has been given from 8th Nov 2020 on the applicant's portal. Applicants applying for Merit Based Admission in the above mentioned courses must complete the process of updating their marks on the

portal latest by 1:00 pm Monday, 23rd Nov 2020.

- iv. In case of Tie in the Qualifying Examination marks, tie-breakers in the following order of preference will be applied:
 - Candidates with higher percentage in Qualifying Examination as mentioned in the eligibility criteria, will be given preference.
 - Candidates with higher percentage in the final year of bachelor degree will be given preference, then preceding year and so on.
 - Candidates having higher aggregate marks (five subjects including one language) in class XII Board examination will be given preference.
