

Report

The session began with an explanation of why interviews are essential, detailing the Personal Interview (PI) process and its various stages, such as technical and HR rounds. Following this, the Speaker advised the students on how to effectively present themselves during interviews by focusing on aspects like appearance, body language, and communication style, which are crucial for making a positive impression. The session then delved into what companies typically seek in candidates, emphasizing qualities like problem-solving skills, cultural fit, and adaptability. Following this, the speaker discussed how panelists assess interviewees, highlighting factors like confidence, consistency in responses, and ability to handle stress. Practical advice on preparation was shared, covering mock interviews, researching the company, and refining answers to common questions. The do's and dont's of interviews were emphasized, such as the importance of honesty, clarity, and avoiding overconfidence or negativity. The session then concluded with a Q&A session, where students had the opportunity to ask questions and clarify any doubts they may have had.







Image 1: Speaker discussing the various types of interviews and guiding the students with the tips to crack them.






