1. Background

The **Big Butterfly Month: India 2020**, a first of its kind event was launched on 5th September 2020 and was continued till 20th September 2020. As a part of this event, a webinar was organised by the **Eco Club** of Sri Venkateswara College in collaboration with Bombay Natural History Society (BNHS) and Society for Environment and Development (SED), to create awareness about butterflies and highlight their role as an important component of the ecosystem. The webinar was planned by the faculty coordinator Dr. Abhishek Chandra. He coordinated with Dr Vartika Mathur, Eco Club Convener and Dr Robin Suyesh, Faculty Organizing Member. Dr S. Venkata Kumar, Ag. Principal of the college provided immense support for the successful completion of the event. Webinar student coordinators Ms. Tanvi Agarwal and Mr. Aniruddh Jhanwar managed the registrations and streaming.

The webinar was organised on 18th September 2020 and the registrations were done via Google forms. In this webinar We have 136 registered participants both student and faculty from 16 state across India which include 31 university (10 central and 21 state and private University) and its 36 colleges across the India from Jammu and Kashmir to Tamilnadu as well as Rajasthan to North-East state. The participants number was fluctuating due to network issue at participants end. The 65 participants has continually with us in webinar (rest joined and left and again joined) from all over India were part of this event and the event was successful in creating the intended impact.

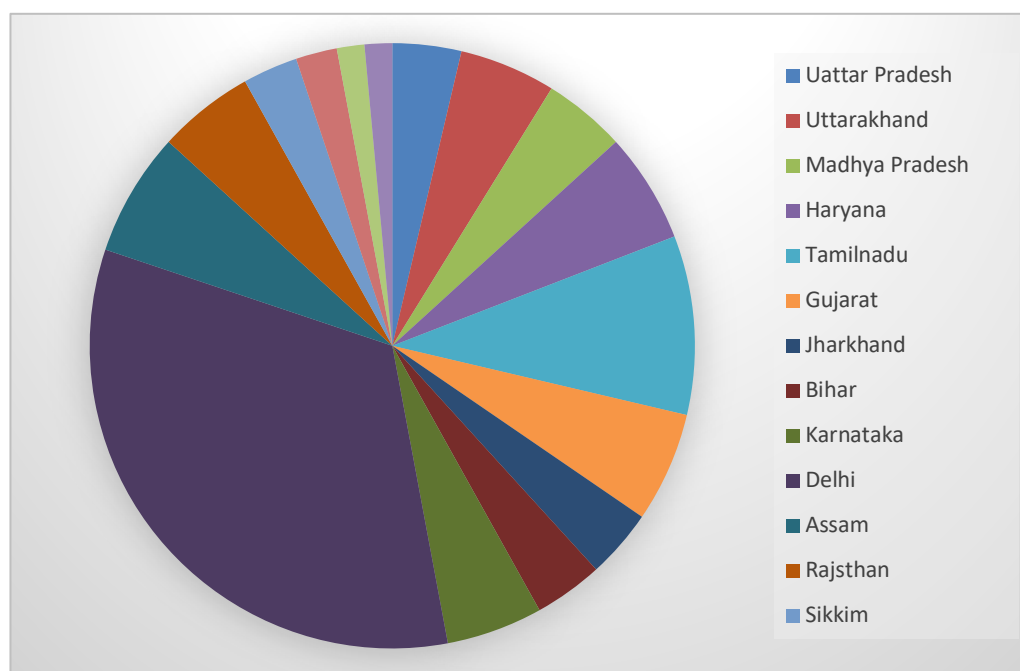


Figure 1: State wise registered participants.

2. Event

The event was scheduled on Google Meets platform. The event was hosted by Eco Club, Sri Venkateswara College, University of Delhi.

The event began with the delivery of opening remarks by Dr. Abhishek Chandra, Webinar Faculty Coordinator. A precise and insightful speech was then delivered to the attendees by Dr. Vartika Mathur who is the Convener of Eco Club, Sri Venkateswara College, University of Delhi, followed by an insight into ecotourism by Dr. S. Venkata Kumar, Ag. Principal of Sri Venkateswara College.

The speaker for the event was Mr. Abhishek Gulson, Educator, and founder of the Nature Education and Awareness Initiative 'NINOX- Owl about Nature' and the author of the weekly column; 'In my backyard', in the Hindu. Mr. Abhishek delivered a very informative and interesting talk on "Importance of Butterflies in the Sustainability of Environment" with a general introduction about butterflies and then an insight about how important butterflies. Various host plants specific to the commonly found butterflies in India were also discussed.

Dr. Robin Suyesh, Organizing Faculty Member, Eco Club proposed the vote of thanks which marked the end of the webinar.

The event was very interactive with both the speaker and the students getting involved actively in the talk. The participants were very satisfied with the quality of the talk. A large no. of questions were taken up after the event and Mr. Gulshan answered each of the questions with utter patience and clarity.

The event provided a huge opportunity for everyone to have a general awareness about the importance of butterflies as key species in maintain a balance in the ecosystem. The event was largely impactful and the overwhelming responses by audience motivate the

organisers to plan more events like this. The effort by the Eco Club of Sri Venkateswara College is to be largely acknowledged.

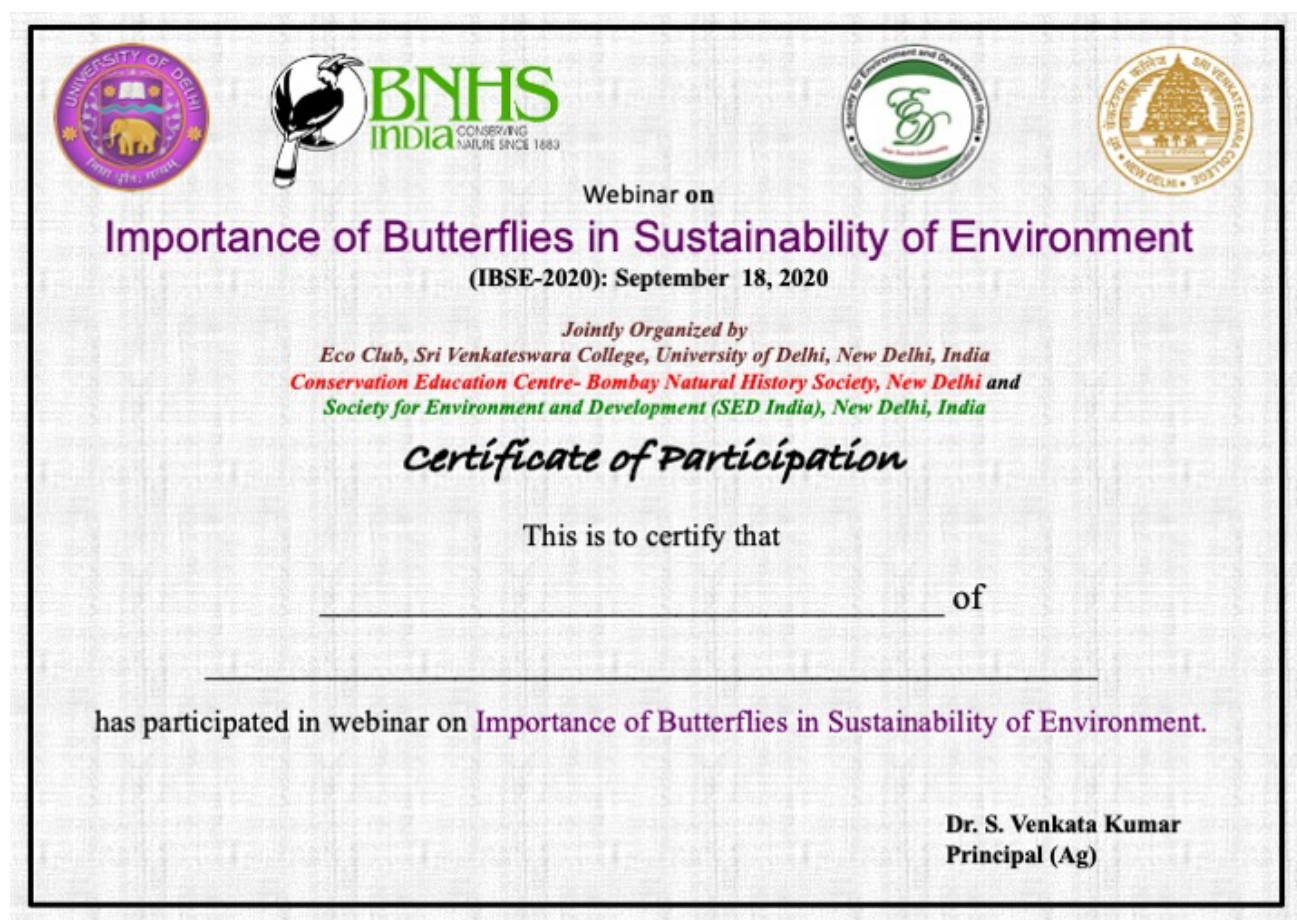
