Summary Report:



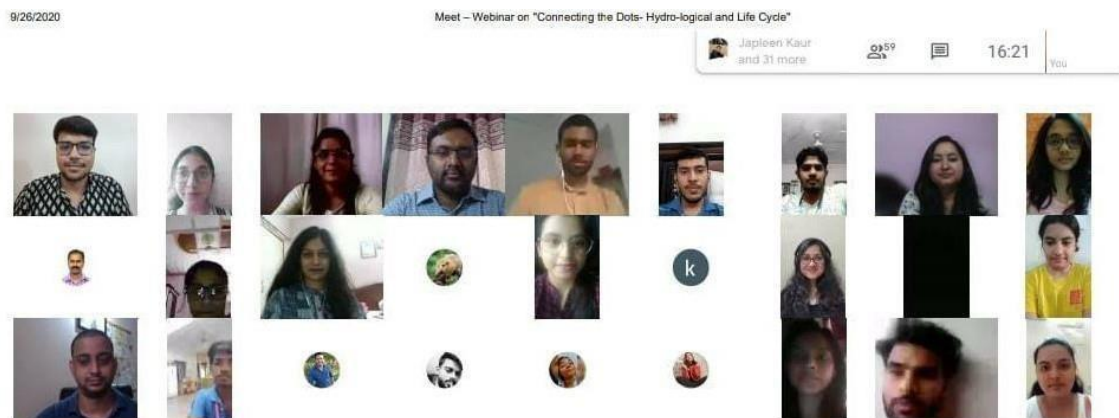
