STUDENTS UNION ELECTION :: 2024-2025

- The students with one year standing in the College shall be eligible to contest election for the Post of President and Secretary of the Sri Venkateswara College Students Union.
- 2. It is pertinent to mention here that all the office-bearers of the Union will be directly elected by and from amongst the members of the Union by a simple majority vote in accordance with the university constitution and the rules framed thereunder; provided that the Vice-President and the Joint-Secretary will be elected by the members of the Union from among such of the members of the Union as will not be taking a final year examination of the University during the year in which they seek election of the office of the Vice-President or Joint-Secretary.
- 3. No student shall be eligible to contest and/or hold a post of Office-Bearer for more than one academic year and in case of Central Councillors of DUSU, this period is restricted to two years. Further, no candidate is allowed to contest for more than one post.
- 4. Candidates contesting for any post in the Sri Venkateswara College Students Union Elections, are not allowed to propose or second the name of any other candidate for the same post.
- No Candidate is allowed to propose or second his/her own candidature for any post. No Student/Candidate is allowed to propose or second the names of more than one candidate for the same post.
- 6. Only those students who pay their fees within the stipulated period (i.e. upto 18th September, 2024), as prescribed by the University of Delhi, are eligible to vote and file Nominations for the DUSU as well as Sri Venkateswara College Students Union Elections to be held on 27th September, 2024.
- 7. <u>Under-Graduate Students between the ages of 17 and 22 as on 16th August of that academic year may contest elections.</u> For Post-Graduate Students the maximum age limit to legitimately contest an election would be 25 years as on 16th August of the year of the elections.
- 8. The filled in Nomination Paper should be dropped in the sealed box kept in the Office of the Principal on all working days from 10.00 AM to 2.00 PM but in no case later than 3.00 PM, on 19th September, 2024.
- 9. The candidate should have attained the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the University of 75% attendance in Theory (including Sports/ECA Attendance, whichever applicable) in the preceding year. However, this condition is not applicable for a student of First Year in the College. The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of Office-Bearer, and two opportunities to contest for the post of an Executive Member.

10. Further, the contestants should not have failed in the preceding academic year and/or re-admitted in the current year as per university rules.

- 11. The candidate shall not have a previous criminal record, that is to say he should not have been tried and/or convicted of any criminal offence or misdemeanor. The candidate shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the College/University authorities.
- 12. The candidate must be a regular, full-time student of the college/university. Please note that all eligible candidates must be enrolled in a full time course and the course duration shall be at least one year.

ELECTION RELATED EXPENDITURE AND FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY

- 1. The maximum permitted expenditure per candidate shall be Rs 5000/-.
- 2. Each candidate shall, within two weeks of the declaration of the result, submit complete and certified account to the College Authorities, as per notification by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. The College shall publish such account s within 2 days of submission of such accounts, through a suitable medium so that any member of the student body may freely examine the same.
- 3. The election of the candidate will be nullified in the event of any non-compliance or in the event of any excessive expenditure.

Union of India & Ors. (Defacement Case), the Delhi Prevention of Defacement of Property Act, 2007 and NGT Order may be seen on DU Website/College Website, which shall remain in force from the date of the notification (s).
