TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Webinar on 'Feminism, Social Justice and Media'
OBJECTIVES	The webinar aimed to help students understand the role of media in the feminist movement, describing its opportunities and limitations. In a very fast-growing and changing environment where media is a part of our everyday life, the webinar addressed how being connected on online platforms is a necessity for political voices to be heard, recognized and raised. A tool kit was shared so that the students can further learn about how to correctly discuss and report an issue.
METHODOLOGY	The webinar was conducted by the Women's Development Cell of Sri Venkateswara College. The event was open to students in and outside of the college. It was followed by a mediated discussion between the attendees. Finally, a Question-Answer Round was organized to address doubts of the attendees.

Event report Attested by Event Coordinator & IQAC Coordinator:

The Women Development Cell of Sri Venkateswara College organised a webinar on 'Feminism, Social Justice and Media' on 14th November, 2021. Our guest for the session was Ms. Shriya Roy, the multimedia editor at Feminism in India who is also an alumnus of Sri Venkateswara College. The session was facilitated by our joint secretary Niharika Rao.

The workshop proceeded with Ms Roy sharing her thoughts on feminism, social justice and the media's representation of contemporary feminism. This sparked an important discussion on intersectionality, harms of limiting feminism to women and caste based sexual violence.

She stressed on how gender-based violence portrayed in media (both visual and print) provide a sense of voyeurism because of lack of trigger warning and use of clickbait headlines to attract consumers. along with familiarizing the attendees about the POSH (Prevention of Sexual Harassment Law).

Shriya then shared a tool-kit with the WDC team, which had instructions on how to use visuals surrounding sensitive topics correctly and how more agency/ power can be given to the survivors rather than the perpetrators.

A short discussion on Sports Journalism was followed by a Q&A round, where the members got to address their doubts regarding the discussion.

The informative webinar was concluded with a vote of thanks by our convenor Dr. Rina Ramdev. We look forward to more such important discussions.
