BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACTIVITY

TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Speaker Session- Gender Sensitization
OBJECTIVES	 To raise awareness about the issue of Gender Based Violence and increase gender sensitivity. To bring attention to the prevalence and seriousness of violence against women in the society at large, highlighting the need for collective action, especially through men. To emphasize the importance of gender equality, advocating for equal rights, opportunities, and treatment for women in all aspects of life, and also highlighting how patriarchy affects men aswell. To empower women by providing them with a platform to express their experiences, concerns, and demands, fostering a sense of solidarity and support and promoting a culture of respect and safety.

METHODOLOGY	The speaker Mr Sadani highlighted the prevalence of gender based violence and how patriarchy affects both men and women equally, hence the need for an equal power sharing in the society is necessary. It was an open forum for participants to share their thoughts, and discuss broader issues of gender inequality and oppression by discussion after viewing various clips about the same.
INVITED SPEAKERS WITH AFFLIATION DETAILS (IF ANY)	Mr. Harish Sadani, the Co-Founder of "Men Against Violence and Abuse" (MAVA).
OUTCOMES	 Increased Awareness on Gender Issues: The session raised awareness on critical gender issues such as gender-based violence, victim-blaming, patriarchy, and toxic masculinity. Participants were exposed to a broader understanding of gender and societal structures. Critical Examination of Media and Culture: The speaker's critique of Bollywood's portrayal of women and the use of problematic phrases highlighted the negative impact of media and popular culture on gender stereotypes, encouraging participants to be more critical of the media they consume. Involvement of Men and Boys in Gender Equality: MAVA's approach to engaging men and boys in discussions on gender equality offered participants a fresh perspective. This underscored the need for men's active participation in dismantling patriarchal systems and promoting equality, which is often absent in gender movements. Safe Spaces for Learning and Reflection: By creating a safe space for men and boys to learn, unlearn, and reflect, the session encouraged openness and dialogue around gender sensitivity, providing avenues for further personal and societal transformation.

Brief Report:

On 6th September, 2024, the Women Development Cell, SVC organised a session on 'gender sensitization' that took place in the seminar hall, Durgabai Deshmukh block and commenced at 2pm. Our esteemed speaker, Mr Harish Sadani is the co-founder of MAVA- Men against violence and abuse, a registered organisation which has been working to address gender-based violence and discrimination against women since 1993.

The speaker opened the discussion by addressing important and sensitive topics, such as gender-based violence and victim-blaming, particularly in light of the recent Kolkata rape case. He delved on the importance of recognition of three genders and understanding the opposite gender and discussed topics like male dominance, patriarchy, and gender stereotyping, highlighting the negative portrayal of women in Bollywood movies. He criticised the use of problematic phrases that strip people of accountability and toxic masculinity and explored how such depictions influence young boys, emphasising the necessity to include men and boys in important dialogues regarding gender sensitivity, sexuality and gender equality.


MAVA's strategies, thus, seek to address the absence of men in gender equality movements. Focusing on engaging men and boys in these conversations, offering them a safe space to learn, unlearn, and reflect, while also organising various programs, workshops, and initiatives to advance the cause.




