**BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACTIVITY**

<b>TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY</b>	Lok Samvaad 2.0 featured a Youth Parliament simulation where participants assumed political roles to debate the agenda: <b>Centre–State Relations with emphasis on Fiscal Federalism</b> . The discussion highlighted issues of financial autonomy, resource distribution, and cooperative governance. The event also included a Paper Presentation on <b>Environmental Politics in India</b> : The Conflict between Development Projects and Environmental Conservation. Participants examined how India balances economic growth with ecological preservation, presenting research and case studies on this pressing challenge.
<b>OBJECTIVES</b>	The MUN and Global Affairs Society of Sri Venkateswara College conducted this conference with the aim of encouraging the minds of the budding diplomats to discuss and deliberate upon the contemporary issues and simulate an environment to test their critical thinking abilities with respect to issues of national and international importance.
<b>METHODOLOGY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The <b>Youth Parliament</b> was moderated and evaluated by a panel of three Executive Board members, who ensured procedural control and assessed participant performance during deliberations.</li><li>• The <b>Paper Presentation</b> was judged by a panel comprising a professor and a research scholar, who evaluated submissions on the basis of research quality, relevance, and presentation skills.</li></ul>

It encouraged critical reflection on the balance between development and conservation, fostering awareness of sustainable policy approaches. Overall, the event successfully combined experiential learning with scholarly inquiry, strengthening participants' analytical, communication, and research abilities.</li></ul>

**Date:** 28th March 2026

The event commenced with delegate verification at the registration desk from **8:45 AM to 9:30 AM**, followed by the **Opening Ceremony**. At **9:30 AM**, the **Youth Parliament committee sessions began**, with delegates engaging in structured debate on **Centre–State relations and fiscal federalism**. Session 1 ran until 12:30 PM, after which delegates broke for lunch. **Session 2 resumed from 1:00 PM to 3:30 PM**, continuing deliberations with greater intensity. The **Closing Ceremony** followed, featuring addresses from the judges, the President of the Society Mr. Parth Loya, and concluding remarks from the Secretariat. The Youth Parliament dispersed at **5:00 PM**. Simultaneously, the **Paper Presentation competition commenced with reporting at 1:00 PM**. Presentations were delivered from **1:30 PM to 3:30 PM**, showcasing research on **environmental politics in India**. The **Closing Ceremony**, common to both competitions, **began at 3:30 PM**, including speeches, felicitation of winners, and acknowledgments of the Executive Board and Secretariat. The event concluded with **dispersal at 5:00 PM**.


