स्चना / NOTICE

All the Undergraduate Students are directed to fill the GE, GE(L), and DSE Options for Semester III, V, and VII on or before 27th July, 2025 by logging onto the ERP Portal.

- The students of Semester III can opt for ONE GE/DSE Paper.
- The students of Semester V can opt for ONE GE and ONE DSE Paper.
- The students of Semester VII can opt for THREE DSEs or TWO DSEs and ONE GE or ONE DSE and TWO
- The students of Life Science need to study at least one DSE in either semester III/IV, and then in all the following semesters and do a dissertation in that stream in both Semesters VII and VIII. In case a Life science student does not want to do a dissertation, s/he needs to choose FOUR DSEs from the major discipline in both Semesters VII and VIII.

Note:

- 1. Check the eligibility/pre-requisites for the courses and apply only if you are eligible/fulfil prerequisites for the course.
- 2. The students must go through the detailed instructions given below before filling in the option form.
- 3. It is mandatory for all the students to fill out the GE, GE(L), and DSE options on ERP Portal.

For All Courses

- Students pursuing Hons. Courses: Students cannot opt for a GE offered by the parent department. For example, a student pursuing Hindi (Hons.) can opt for GE of any department excluding the Department of Hindi.
- Students pursuing Hons. Courses: Students of Semester III/VII can also opt for DSE offered by departments other than their parent department as GE.
- 7 GEs of a particular department qualify a student for a minor in that subject, provided they have a major degree.
- Major is only possible after Semester VIII.

For B.A. (Prog)

- GE should be different from core subjects.
- All B.A. (Prog) students can choose any one GE paper from a pool of languages (English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu).
- Semester I and III students of SVC to choose English as GE; if English is their core paper, then they can choose GE from the open pool/ or choose any other MIL from GE(L) Pool.
- Semester V/VII students to choose GE from open pool only, since they have done languages in SEM I-IV.
- Semester VII students need to study THREE DSEs of the Major Discipline.
- Students opting for Hindi as GE must note the following:



- II. Hindi B- for students who studied Hindi up to class X.
- III. Hindi C- for students who studied Hindi up to class VIII.
- Students with one language as the core discipline can choose only one GE(L) (which will be two courses of the same language, which may be studied as GE-1 and GE-3 or GE-2 and GE-4). The other two GEs shall be from the open pool of GEs.
- B.A.(Prog) Students who have never studied any Modern Indian Language (MIL) up to Class VIII can choose from the open pool of GEs.
- The language in Semester III should be different from the language chosen in Semester II.
- The language in Semester III should be the same as the language chosen in Semester I.

B.A. (Prog) Semester I/II	No Language	English GE language in Semester I and Hindi GE language in Semester II
	One Language	One language (other than core) in Semester I and III or II and IV. Other GE from open Pool.
B.A. (Prog) Semester III/IV	No Language	English GE language in Semester III and Hindi in Semester IV
	One Language	One language (other than core) in Semester I and III or II and IV. Other GE from open Pool

For B.Com. (Prog)

- All B.Com. (Prog) Students can choose any one GE paper from a pool of languages (English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu).
- Semester I and Semester III students of SVC to choose Hindi as GE.
- Language in Semester III should be different from the language chosen in Semester II.
- Language in Semester III should be the same as in Semester I.
- B.Com. (Prog) students who have never studied any Modern Indian Language (MIL) up to Class VIII can choose from the open pool of GEs.
- Students opting for Hindi as GE must note the following:
 - I. Hindi A -for students who studied Hindi up to class XII.
 - II. Hindi B- for students who studied Hindi up to class X.
 - III. Hindi C- for students who studied Hindi up to class VIII.
- SEM VII students may also take DSE of non-parent department as GE.

For Life Science

- They can take GE from departments other than Chemistry, Botany, and Zoology.
- They need to choose DSE offered by the departments of Chemistry/Botany/Zoology only.
- Semester III/V/VII students should choose DSE based on their choice of major.
- Semester III students can opt for DSE of Chemistry, Botany, Zoology in place of GE.
- The concept of major and minor comes only if the students pursue EIGHT/FOUR Semesters/Years of UG course.
- Students can get a minor only in Chemistry/Botany/Zoology
- Students cannot get a minor in non-core subjects, since they need to do 9 DSEs for a major. This leaves the option for 5 GEs. So, the 28 credit points cannot be accumulated for a minor in non-core papers.
- Those students of Semester III/V/VII who are not looking to major in any core discipline may choose GE in SEM III and DSE from any parent department in SEM V/VII.
- For a major degree, they need to study at least one DSE in either semester III/IV, and then in all the following semesters and do a dissertation in that stream in both Semesters VII and VIII

For Bioscience

They can opt for any GE from the GE Pool.
