Notice to College Students: Mandatory Submission of Online UGC Anti-Ragging Affidavit

As part of the University Grants Commission (UGC)'s ongoing efforts to eliminate ragging in higher educational institutions, **all students are required to submit an online Anti-Ragging Affidavit annually within the prescribed timeline. This process is mandatory all the students of the college.**

In accordance with UGC regulations and the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, **all students are required to submit an online Anti-Ragging Affidavit to promote a safe and inclusive academic environment.** The affidavit shall be submitted via the following link : [https://www.antiragging.in/affidavit affiliated form.php](https://www.antiragging.in/affidavit%20affiliated%20form.php). On visiting the UGC website, the *Undertaking* tab must be selected, **and the student must complete the mandatory registration to access the form.**

The form requires entry of personal details such as name, e-mail ID, and mobile number, along with the details of the parent or guardian, including name and contact information. College and course details must also be provided by selecting the state and the name of the college, entering the name and contact number of the College Principal, specifying the course type (UG/PG/Certificate/Diploma), current year of study, **and the nearest police station to the college, i.e., University of Delhi South Campus, New Delhi.**

UGC's regulations on ragging must be carefully read and acknowledged. A confidential survey included in the form must also be completed. After filling in all required information, the details should be reviewed for accuracy before final submission.

Upon successful submission, a Reference ID will be generated. Use this ID to download both the Student's Anti-Ragging Undertaking and the Parent's/Guardian's undertaking. Finally, submit the printed affidavits to the **Dealing Assistants (Administration)** during working hours on or before **3rd September, 2025** for updating the admission.
