Designed to encourage teamwork, observation, and problem-solving, the hunt saw enthusiastic participation from various departments. The event concluded with a victory by a spirited team from the **Biochemistry Department**.

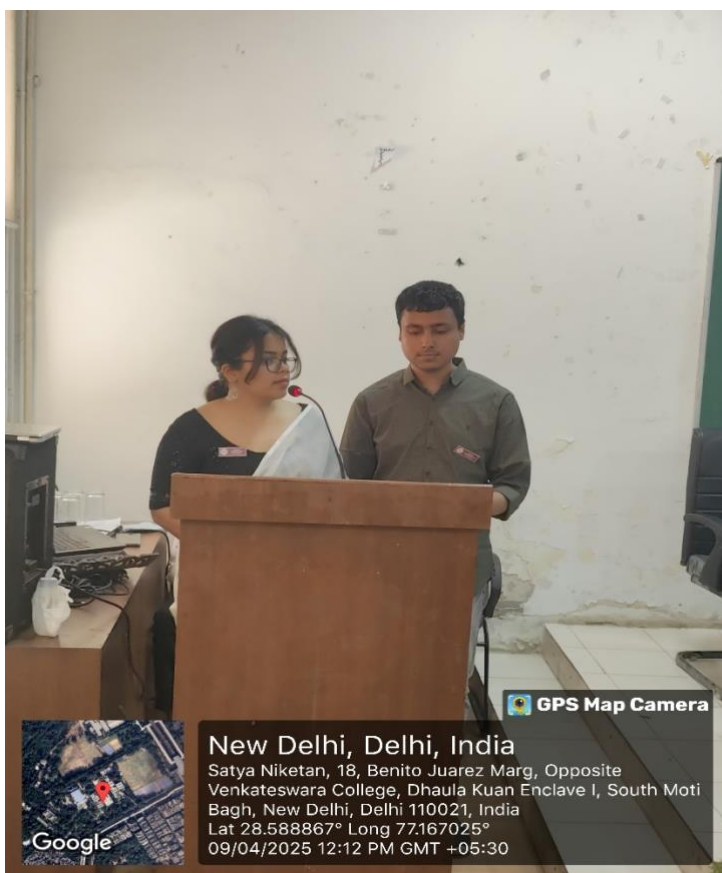

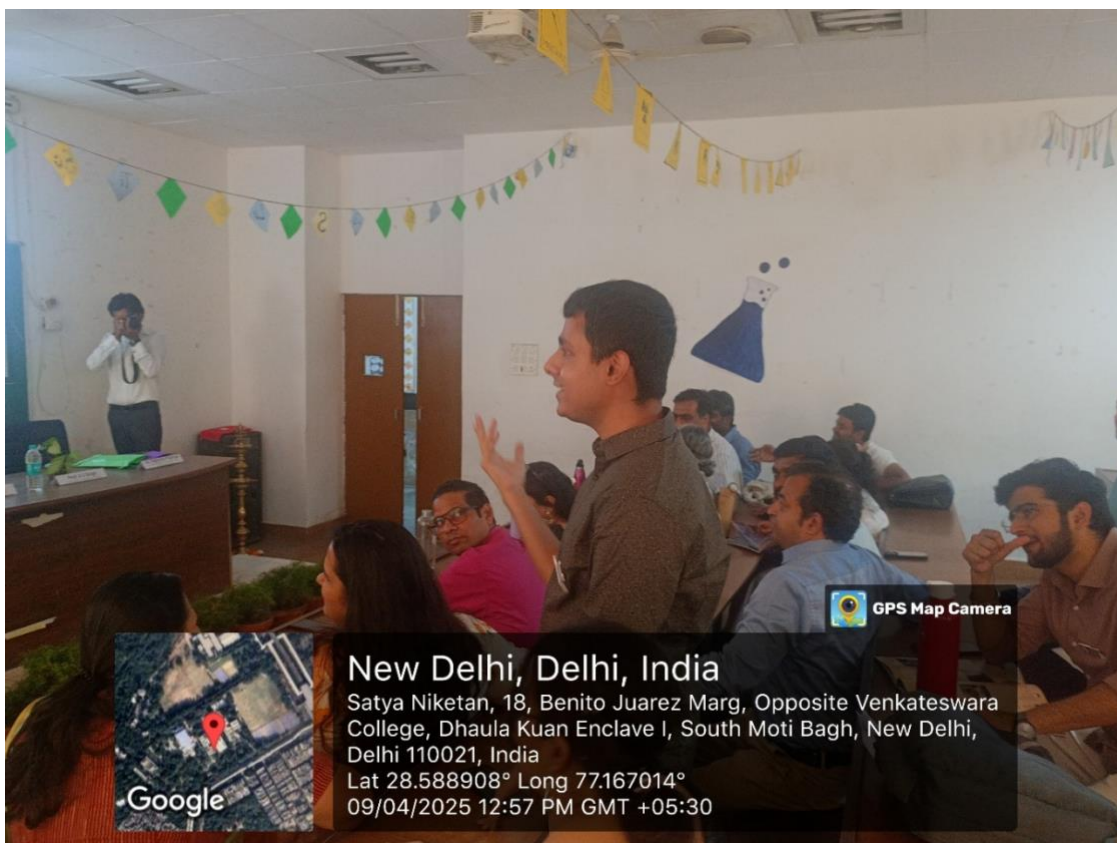

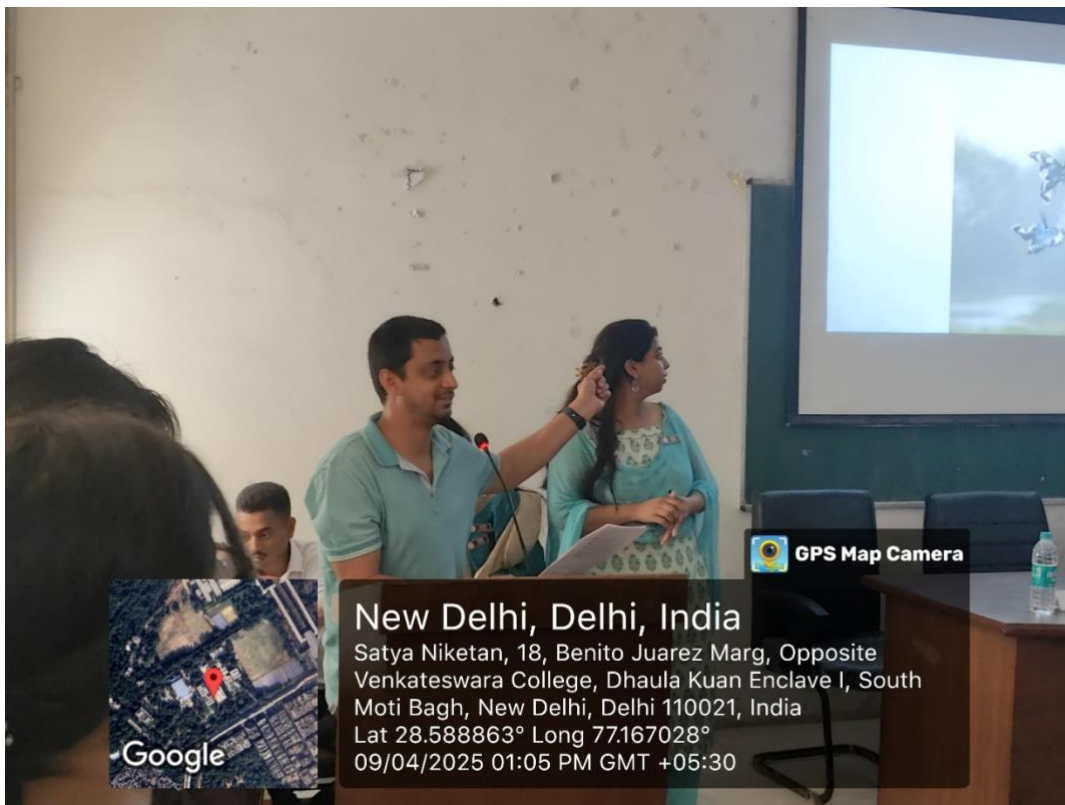

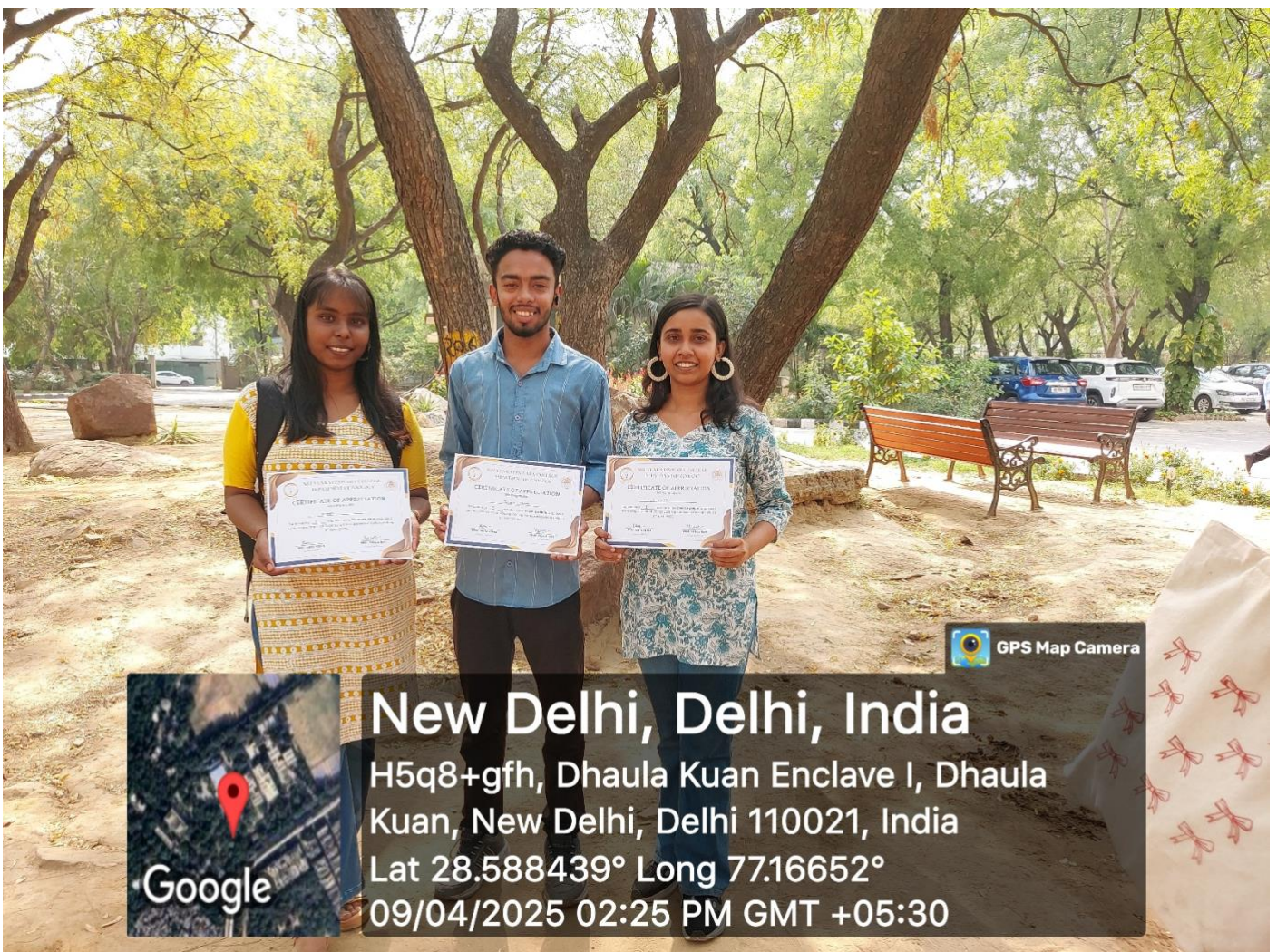
