TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Feminising Labour Protests: Women Workers' Militancy and collective Actions in late colonial Bombay (1920-1940)
OBJECTIVES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To question old views that mostly credit men in labor movements, helping students see a fuller picture of gender roles in class struggles.• To show that women workers played important roles, encouraging students to include different viewpoints in history.• To explore how women took part in strikes and protests, showing the value of looking at everyone's contributions in historical events.• To introduce students to new archives, inspiring them to find fresh sources for their own research and helping answer questions about where to begin.
METHODOLOGY	We invited Dr. Robert Rahman Raman to speak on the topic. We encouraged students participate in this session. We made all the necessary plans to hold the seminar. Dr. Raman delivered an engaging lecture, and the session ended with an interactive question and answer segment.

INVITED SPEAKERS WITH AFFLIATION DETAILS (IF ANY)	Robert Rahman Raman holds a doctoral degree in modern Indian history from the Centre for Modern Indian Studies (CeMIS), University of Göttingen. His research interests are Labour History, Urban Studies, Popular Mobilizations, and anti-colonial movements, with expertise in the history of Bombay’s mill workers. He is currently a Postdoctoral fellow at the Lakshmi Mittal South Asia Institute, Harvard University.
