<b>METHODOLOGY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The seminar was organized by the <b>Department of History, Sri Venkateswara College, on 14 October 2025.</b></li> <li>• The session featured a <b>lecture by Dr. Rameshwar Prasad Bahuguna</b>, an eminent historian and retired professor from <b>Jamia Millia Islamia.</b></li> <li>• Dr. Bahuguna presented his research through a <b>thematic lecture</b> focusing on Mughal–Rajput political relations, supported by <b>historical evidence and scholarly references.</b></li> <li>• He drew on the works of <b>other historians, such as B. D. Chattopadhyaya</b>, to substantiate his arguments and broaden the analytical framework.</li> <li>• The seminar concluded with an <b>interactive Q&amp;A session</b>, encouraging students to clarify doubts, ask questions, and engage in scholarly discussion.</li> </ul>

He retired as a professor from Department of History and Culture at Jamia Millia Islamia. He also directed the <b>Centre for Distance and Open Learning</b> from 2018 to 2021.</p>

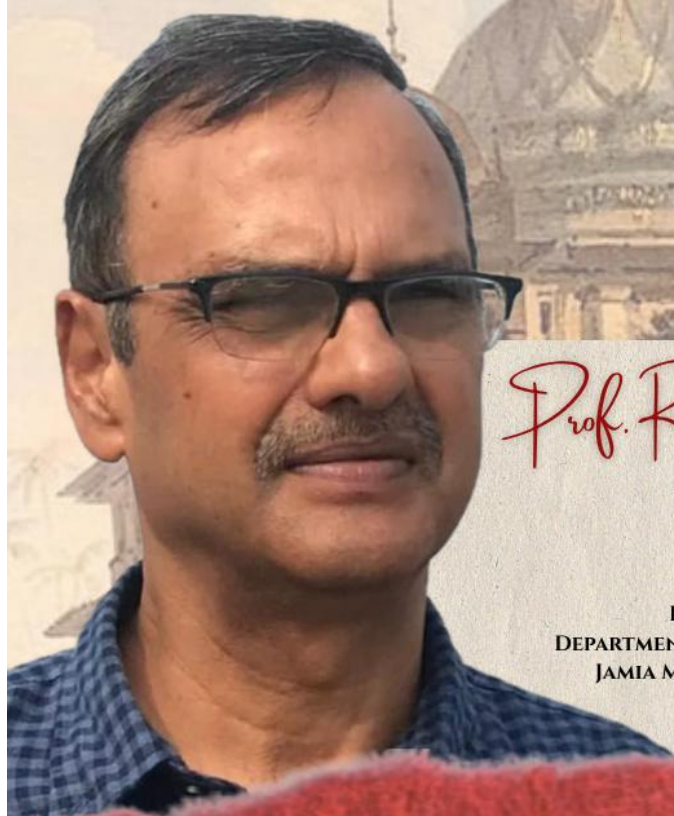

## BREIF REPORT

On **14 October 2025**, the **Department of History, Sri Venkateswara College**, organized an enlightening and thought-provoking seminar on the topic “*Rajput Polities in the Age of the Delhi Sultanate.*” The distinguished speaker for the session was **Dr. Rameshwar Prasad Bahuguna**, a retired Professor from the **Department of History and Culture, Jamia Millia Islamia**. The seminar aimed to provide students and history enthusiasts with a deeper understanding of the political and cultural interactions between the Rajputs and the Mughals, while also challenging several common misconceptions about the Mughal dynasty and their alliances with the Rajputs through marriage and diplomacy.

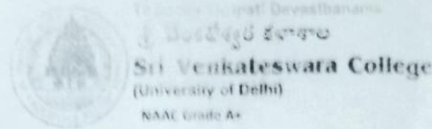
During the session, **Dr. Bahuguna** offered his insights that reshaped our understanding of the Mughals and their political identity. He explained, for instance, how the Mughals avoided the conventional Muslim royal title “*Sultan*”, and how their distinction lay in their **political claims, administrative styles**, and the **evolving South Asian context** of kingship. He clarified that, in medieval India, the Mughals were not viewed as *mlechchhas* (barbarians), but rather as *Yavanas*, a term used for foreign rulers from the West or Central Asia. He also discussed the **varied Rajput responses** to Mughal rule and how regions such as **Mewar and Marwar** resisted, while the **Rajputs of Amber (Jaipur)** were among the first to form alliances with them. He highlighted that many Mughal emperors were **half-Rajput through their maternal lineage**, illustrating the depth of Rajput–Mughal interactions. Furthermore, he shed light on the **political relations among different Rajput polities** and pointed out several instances where **historical information has been inaccurately represented in NCERT textbooks**.

Throughout the session, Dr. Bahuguna spoke with clarity, eloquence, and scholarly depth, frequently referencing the works of historians such as **B. D. Chattopadhyaya** to reinforce his arguments. His engaging and approachable manner encouraged students to actively participate in the **Q&A session**, where he patiently and thoughtfully addressed their queries. Despite time constraints forcing an early conclusion, the seminar proved to be an intellectually stimulating and memorable experience.
