OBJECTIVES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To examine Delhi's historical evolution from ancient to modern times through multidisciplinary perspectives.• To deepen students' understanding of Delhi's cultural, religious, linguistic, and architectural transformations across centuries.• To highlight the role of Sufism, literature, art, archaeology, and urban studies in shaping Delhi's identity.• To correct common misconceptions about Delhi's past by presenting evidence-based interpretations from leading scholars.• To promote critical engagement with themes such as sacred geography, heritage conservation, colonial representation, and urban change.• To provide a platform for scholars, students, and researchers to interact with experts and explore diverse methodological approaches to studying Delhi.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To encourage appreciation for marginalized or overlooked contributors to Delhi’s history, such as tawaifs, Qawwals, eunuchs, women patrons, and migrant communities.
METHODOLOGY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The two-day conference Delhi Through the Ages was organized by the Indian Council of Historical Research (ICHR) on 3-4 November 2025. • The event featured keynote lectures by eminent historians including Dr. Swapna Liddle and Dr. Neekee Chaturvedi. • Six academic panels were conducted, covering themes like Sufism, baolis, sacred spaces, literary representations, colonial urbanism, and heritage conservation. • Scholars presented research-based papers drawing on inscriptions, archival texts, archaeological reports, artworks, poetry, oral traditions, and literary sources. • Presentations applied interdisciplinary methods, including visual analysis, textual criticism, urban morphology studies, and material culture interpretation. • The conference included sessions on heritage processes such as UNESCO nominations and museum narratives, supported by case studies (e.g., Charaideo Moidams, Partition Museum). • A dedicated Q&A and feedback session allowed senior historians (notably Dr. Swapna Liddle and Dr. Abhijeet Kumar) to offer critiques, clarifications, and recommendations. • Students and participants actively engaged with presenters through discussions on historiography, archival gaps, and reinterpretation of Delhi’s cultural memory.

<p>OUTCOMES</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participants gained a holistic and nuanced understanding of Delhi’s long historical trajectory, from prehistoric settlements to contemporary urban forms. • The conference clarified misconceptions regarding Sufi practices, tawaif culture, linguistic evolution, and colonial architectural motives. • Students learned how interdisciplinary approaches enrich historical analysis, blending archaeology, literature, art, religion, and urban studies. • Attendees recognized the importance of critical reading of sources, questioning colonial biases, romanticized memories, and gaps in archival representation. • The presentations highlighted the need to preserve endangered heritage, such as baolis, vernacular neighborhoods, and traditional performing arts like Qawwali. • The event encouraged participants to reflect on heritage politics, museum narratives, and the challenges of conservation in a rapidly changing cityscape.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Q&A session fostered deeper academic curiosity, prompting students to pursue further research on Delhi’s sacred spaces, cultural identities, and historical transformations. • Overall, the conference strengthened engagement between scholars and students, promoting informed, analytical, and inclusive approaches to studying Delhi.


