Regarding Selection of GE and GEL Options
ONLY FOR SEMESTER II

All the Undergraduate Students of Semester II are directed to go through this notice regarding the GE and GEL Courses they can opt for before filing out the Course Allocation Form (CAF).

The students are instructed

1. To go through the List of GE and GEL Courses available in the college.
2. To go through the syllabi of the available courses and discuss them with their Teachers/Mentors/Parents/Peers before filling out the Course Allocation Form. The Syllabi of all the courses can be accessed through the following links:

3. To check the eligibility and/or pre-requisites for the courses and apply only if they are eligible and fulfill the prerequisites for the course.
4. To go through the detailed instructions given in this notice before filling out the option form.

Important Notes:

1. It is mandatory for all students to fill out the GE and GEL options on the ERP Portal only. The ERP will be OPENED SOON. Students are advised to check the college website and DigiCampus regularly for updates.
2. Students are instructed to fill out the Course Allocation Form (CAF) without fail, as the attendance will be marked from the very next day of the release of the first List of Allocation.
3. The GE and GEL Courses allocated to the students WILL NOT BE CHANGED in normal circumstances.

Important Instructions (Only for Semester II)

1. Students in Semester II can opt for only one GE or GEL Course.

For All Courses Semester II

1. The discipline of GE/GEL must be different from the Core Discipline. For example, a student pursuing B.A. (Hons) Hindi can opt for GE of any department excluding the Department of Hindi.
2. 7 GEs of a particular discipline/department qualify a student for a minor in that discipline, provided s/he has a major degree.
3. A major degree is possible only after the completion of FOUR Years (EIGHT Semesters) of the Undergraduate course.

For B.A. (Prog) Semester II

1. The students of the B.A. (Prog) can choose any one GEL Course from a pool of languages (English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, and Telugu).

- The students of the B.A. (Prog) have to study two GEL Courses; One in Semesters I & III, and the other in Semesters II & IV. At least one of the languages should be a Modern Indian Language (MIL).
- Note that the GE Languages should be different from both core disciplines.
- The students of the B.A. (Prog) with two languages as core disciplines can choose GE from the open pool (and not restricted to choosing only the GEL Courses).
- The students of the B.A. (Prog) with one language as a core discipline can choose only one GEL (which will be the same courses of the same language that may be studied in either Semesters I & III or Semesters II & IV). The other two GEs shall be from the open pool of GEs.
- The students of the B.A. (Prog) Semester II of our college have to opt for Hindi as GEL, and wait for the other GEL Courses (English, Sanskrit, Tamil, and Telugu) in the next semester.
- Students opting for Hindi as GEL must note the following:
Hindi A -for students who studied Hindi up to class XII.
Hindi B- for students who studied Hindi up to class X.
Hindi C- for students who have studied Hindi up to class VIII
- If Hindi is their core discipline, then they can choose any other MIL (Sanskrit, Tamil, and Telugu) from the GEL Pool or choose GE from the open pool.
- The language to be studied in Semester II should be different from the language studied in Semester I.
- The language to be studied in Semester III would be the same as the language studied in Semester I.
- The students of the B.A. (Prog) who have never studied any Modern Indian Language (MIL) up to Class VIII can choose from the open pool of GEs.

For B.Com. (Prog) Semester II

- The students of the B.Com. (Prog) can choose any one GEL Course from a pool of languages (English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu).
- The students of the B.Com. (Prog) have to study two GEL Courses; One is Semesters I & III, and the other is Semesters II & IV. At least one of the languages should be an Indian Language.
- The students of the B.Com. (Prog) Semester II of our college have to opt for English as GEL, and wait for the other GEL Courses (Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu) in the next semester.
- The language to be studied in Semester II should be different from the language studied in Semester I.
- The language to be studied in Semester III would be the same as the language studied in Semester I.
- The students of the B.Com. (Prog) who have never studied any Modern Indian Language (MIL) up to Class VIII can choose from the open pool of GEs.

For B.Sc. (Prog) Life Sciences Semester II

1. The students of the B.Sc. (Prog) Life Sciences can take any GE Course from departments other than Botany, Chemistry, and Zoology.
2. The students of the B.Sc. (Prog) Life Sciences can get a minor degree only in Botany/Chemistry/Zoology.
3. The students of the B.Sc. (Prog) Life Sciences cannot get a minor degree in non-core disciplines, since they need to do 9 DSEs for a major degree. This leaves the option for 5 GEs. So, the 28 credit points cannot be accumulated for a minor in non-core disciplines.
4. The concept of Major and Minor comes only if a student pursues FOUR Years (EIGHT Semesters) of the Undergraduate course.

For B.Sc. (Hons) Biological Sciences Semester II

1. The students of the B.Sc. (Hons) Biological Sciences can opt for any GE Course from the Open Pool.
